10 Sunday Nov 9 1855  
Commenced with strong winds and clear weather Midshipman with Gale from 05.06.06  
Latter part the same saw a Brig bow to  
heading to the Westward to End Lat 30.39 05

11 Monday Nov 10  
Commenced with strong winds from 05.06.06  
heading S.W. Midshipman and Latter part the  
same to End

12 Tuesday Nov 11  
Commenced with fresh Gale and clear weather  
Midshipman strong winds and squally  
Latter part the same to End  
Lat 48.30 05 Long "

13 Wednesday Nov 12  
Commenced with fresh Gale from 05.06.06 and  
sailing weather steering S.W. Midshipman the  
Latter part from moderate but some squally  
Lat 27.22 05 to End Long 43.50 14

14 Friday Nov 13  
Commenced with fresh winds from 05.06.06  
Employed in getting Boats Midshipman the same  
Latter part from weather the first clear day we have  
seen since leaving New Bedford to End

15 Saturday Nov 14  
Commenced with fresh breeze and fine weather  
Employed in ship duty saw a Fair Bark  
Middle and Latter part pleasant Employed  
in breaking out the Green Haul to End  
Lat 41.40 05

16 Sunday Nov 15  
Commenced with fine pleasant weather Employed  
in hauling of between deck Midshipman fine  
weather Latter part the same Employed in  
Ship duty to End  
Lat 43.50 05 Long 51.43 15

17 Monday Nov 16  
Commenced with fresh breeze and squally  
weather took in the light sails Midshipman  
sually with heavy rain and sharp lightning  
saw the Cape Cod Light Latter part squally  
and Brig in sight to End  
Lat 49.31 05 Long 53.30 16

18 Tuesday Nov 17  
Commenced with moderate breeze from the  
steering S.W. 5 sails in light fresh wind  
Latter part the same shortened sail  
saw a Bark and a Brig to End

19 Wednesday Nov 18  
Commenced with strong breeze heading S.W.  
Midshipman moderate wind with sharp  
lightning Latter part had a severe squall  
of wind and heavy rain with heavy thunder  
and sharp lightning which lasted for  
four hours to End with heavy rain
