80. Sunday Jan 18th 1852.
Commenced with fine pleasant weather at
2 P.M. finished stowing down and washed off
saw a carcass. Middlepart calm. Satterpart
fresh breezes from South steering W. by S.
So ends this day.
Lat 35. 20. S. Long 49. 50 W.

81. Monday Jan 19th
Commenced with moderate breezes from east
steering W. by N. at dark took in sail and
luffed to the wind. Middlepart moderate.
Satterpart the same, at 9 A.M. spoke a Dutch
Bark 70 days from New York bound to Buenos
Ayres, at 11 A.M. the Cooper cut himself quite
bad. So ends.
Home S.B.S.

82. Tuesday Jan 20th
Commenced with fine pleasant weather employed
in sheathing the deck a ship and bark in
sight. Middlepart calm. Satterpart fine
breezes, 4 sails in sight. Exchanged signals
with a whaling bark showing the striped and
stars. So ends.
Lat 35. 40. S. Home S.B.S.

83. Wednesday Jan 21st
Commenced with fine breezes from west steering
N.E. at dark took in sail and luffed to the
wind. Middlepart fresh breezes. Satterpart the same.
steering N.E. spoke ship Wain 61 days from
Warren, clean, bound to the Arctic Ocean. Home S.B.S.

Bark Atlantic. Commanded by R. G. Bruce.

84. Thursday Jan 22nd 1852.
Commenced with fresh breezes from South steering
N.E. & C. at dark took in sail. Middlepart fine breezes
Satterpart the same heading N.E. Saw a carcass
So ends this day.
Home S.B.S.
Lat 34. 40. Long 49. 48 W.

85. Friday Jan 23rd
Commenced with moderate breezes and fine weather
steering N.E. struck a porpoise and drew the iron
and lost him. At dark took in the light sails.
Middlepart pleasant. Satterpart the same. Saw grampack
So ends.
Lat 34. 15. S. Long 46. 31. W.

86. Saturday Jan 24th
Commenced with fine breezes from N. steering S. nothing
in sight. At sunset took in sail. Middlepart pleasant
Satterpart the same steering S.W. Saw a Brig steering
N.E. So ends.
Lat 34. 42. S. Long 47. 30. W.

87. Sunday Jan 25th
Commenced with fine breezes from North steering S.W.
Saw a Brig standing to the N.E. at sunset took in
sail. Middlepart pleasant. Satterpart the same.
Exchanged the national flag with a Buenos Ayres
Brigate and two Corvettes steering N.E. So ends A Brig
in sight.

88. Monday Jan 26th
Commenced with fine breezes from N. steering
W. by N. at sunset took in sail. Middlepart fresh
breezes. Satterpart the same steering W. Saw a
Bergu steering E.S.E. So ends.
