146. Wednesday March 24th 1853.
Commenced with moderate weather heading in to the westward in company with the *Saratoga* all hands employed in writing letters home to our friends. Middlepart calm. Batteredpart moderate breeze from E. Steering W. in company with the *Saratoga*. So ends this day. *Home Side.*
Lat 42. 00 N. Long 57. 34 W.

147. Thursday March 25th.
Commenced with light breeze from E. Steering W. in company with the *Saratoga*. At dusk took in sail. Middlepart strong breeze and rain. Batteredpart moderate. *Saratoga* in sight. So ends. *Home Side.*
Lat 41. 45. N. in 45 fathoms of water.

148. Friday March 26th.
Commenced with moderate breeze from N.W. Steering E. At sun set took in sail spoke the *Saratoga*. Middlepart squally. Batteredpart fresh breeze in company with the *Saratoga*. So ends. *Home Side.*
Lat 42. 38. N.

149. Saturday March 27th.
Commenced with fresh breeze from N.W. in company with the *Saratoga* and beating her 12 miles dead to windward. At dusk spoke her. Middlepart moderate. Batteredpart the same. Steering E.N.E. So ends. *Home Side.*
Lat 43. 06. N. in 70 fathoms of water. Long 56. 40 W.

150. Sunday March 28th.
Commenced with fine weather Steering E. At dusk took in sail and luffed to the wind. Middlepart strong winds. Batteredpart the same. So ends. *Home Side.*
Lat 43. 38. N. Long 56. 00 W.

Bark Atlantic.

151. Monday March 29th 1853.
Commenced with strong breeze from N.W. heading N.W. Middlepart pleasant. Batteredpart fresh breeze from N.W. Steering N.E. So ends this day. *Home Side.*
Lat 43. 10 N. Long 55. 40 W.

152. Tuesday March 30th.
Commenced with fresh breeze from N.W. at 2. P.M. luffed ship to the westward and double reefed. At sunset took in sail. Middlepart strong gale furlled the foresail and main topsail and was ship to the N.W. Batteredpart fresh gale from N.W. heading N.W. So ends. *Home Side.*
Lat 43. 50 N. Long 56. 00 W.

153. Wednesday March 31st.
Commenced with strong gale from S. lying to under short sail heading N.W. nothing to do but eat and sleep. Middlepart the same. Batteredpart fresh breeze from W. heading N.W. At double reefed topsails. So ends. *Home Side.*
Lat 43. 40 N. Long 56. 20 W.

154. Thursday April 1st.
Commenced with fresh breeze from W. heading N.W. At sunset took in sail. Middle and Batteredpart fresh breeze. So ends. *Home Side.*
Lat 42. 41 N. Long 56. 16 W.

155. Friday April 2nd.
Commenced with moderate breeze from S. heading W. At sunset took in sail. Middlepart moderate. Batteredpart fresh breeze. So ends. *Home Side.*
Lat 42. 21 N. Long 56. 40 W.
