Middlepart pleasant. Batterpart the same.
Steering N.E. by N. Employed in laring down
rigging. Do ends.

Tuesday May 18th.
Commenced with fine trades from E.N.E.
Steering N.E. by N. Middle and Batterparts the
same. Employed in ships duty. Do ends.
Lat 18. 51. N. Long 45. 16. W. Home Side.

202.

Wednesday May 19th.
Commenced with fine pleasant weather and fresh
trades from E.N.E. Steering N.E. by N. Employed
in ships duty. Middlepart equally.
Batterpart fine weather heading N.E. by N.
Lat 21. 57. N. Long 47. 16. W. Home Side.

203.

Thursday May 20th.
Commenced with fine weather and light
trades from N.E. heading N.E. by N. Employed
in ships duty. Quite a quantity of gull was
in sight. Middlepart pleasant. Batterpart
fresh trades steering N.E. by N. Employed in
various jobs. Do ends.
Lat 24. 47. N. Long 48. 07. W. Home Side.

Friday 21st.
Commenced with equally weather heading N.E. by N.
Employed in ships duty. Middlepart strong
trades. Batterpart fine pleasant weather heading
N.E. by N. Do ends.
Lat 27. 57. N. Long 50. 20. W.
Home Side.

Saturday May 22nd. 1853.
Commenced with pleasant trades from E.N.E. heading
N.E. by N. Employed variously. Middlepart moderate
Batterpart the same heading N.E. by N. Do ends.
Lat 30. 02. N. Long 51. 22. W. Home Side.

Sunday May 23rd.
Commenced with pleasant weather and light winds
from N.E. heading N.E. by N. Middlepart light winds
Batterpart very pleasant. Do ends.
Lat 31. 28. N. Long 52. 30. W. Home Side.

207.

Monday May 24th.
Commenced with fine weather and light breezes
heading N. plenty of fish round but were not hungry
enough to bite at the bait caught 1 ship jink.
Middlepart moderate. Batterpart the same. Employed
in setting up rigging. Do ends.
Lat 32. 21. N. Long 52. 23. W. Home Side.

208.

Tuesday May 25th.
Commenced with light airs heading N.E. by E.
Employed in setting up rigging. At sunset took in
fall. Middlepart pleasant. Batterpart the same.
Employed in setting up rigging. and breaking out
for hold. Do ends.
Lat 32. 57. N. Long. Home Side.

209.

Wednesday May 26th.
Commenced with fine breezes from N.W. steering
E.N.E. at 4 P.M. finished stowing off fore hold.
Saw porpoises. At sunset took in sail and luffed
to the wind with the main yard aback.
Middlepart light breezes. Batterpart the same
steering E.N.E. Do ends.
Lat 32. 50. N. Home Side.
