

Journal of a whaling voyage in the good Bark

299. Saturday June 5th 1853.
Commenced with fine breezes from N.W. Storing
O.C. & C. At 3 P.M. made the island of Sagel
bearing N.E. by S. distant 20 mls. at 5 P.M. took
in Nightails, fished the main sail and
luffed to the rising heading S. Middlepart
luffing off and on. At midnight wind shifted
to the N.W. Batterpart. At daylight beat the
cables and got the anchors ready for anchoring.
At 8 A.M. came to anchor in the harbor of
Sagel in 9 fathoms of water. Sent up the tackle
for breaking out oil. So ends this day.

300. Sunday June 6th.
Commenced with pleasant weather. The Capt.
went on shore and returned on board at 4 P.M.
with some fresh beef and vegetables. At 6 P.M.
took our anchor and warped farther up the
harbor at 7 P.M. again in 10 fathoms water.
Weather thick and rainy. Middlepart thick
weather. Batterpart pleasant. The Starboard watch
on liberty.

301. Monday June 7th.
Commenced with fine weather. The Starboard watch
on liberty at dark returned. Middlepart pleasant.
Batterpart the same. Employed in breaking out
and coopersing oil. So ends.

302. Tuesday June 8th.
Commenced with fine weather. Employed in breaking
out and coopersing oil. At 3 P.M. sent a launch
load of oil ashore. Middlepart calm.
Batterpart Employed in breaking out and coopersing
oil, stowing ground tier and filling with salt
water. Sent a launch load of oil ashore. So ends.

303. Wednesday June 9th 1853.
Commenced with fresh breezes from N. Employed in
coopersing oil and filling salt water. At 6 P.M. strong
breeze let go. Middlepart. Strong breeze.
Batterpart the same. Employed in coopersing oil.

304. Thursday June 10th.
Commenced with fresh breezes. Sent 2 loads of oil
on shore. Middlepart fresh breezes. Batterpart fine
weather. Employed in setting up shooks. So ends.

305. Friday June 11th.
Commenced with fine weather. Employed in setting
up shooks. Middlepart pleasant. Batterpart the
same. Employed in setting up shooks and
stowing off the hold. So ends.

306. Saturday June 12th.
Commenced with fine weather. Employed in
setting up shooks for fresh water. Middlepart
pleasant. Batterpart the same. Sent a load of
casks ashore for water. So ends.

307. Sunday June 13th.
Commenced with fine weather. Employed in stowing
off between decks. at 4 P.M. washed off. Middlepart
pleasant. Batterpart the same. Starboard watch on
liberty. So ends.

308. Monday June 14th.
Commenced with fine weather. Starboard watch on
liberty. at dark returned. Middlepart pleasant.
Batterpart the same. Took on board a launch load
of water.
