Wednesday June 23^d 1853.

Commenced with fine weather and moderate breezes from N.W. heading W. by N. Saw a tail of the starboard beam at sunset took in sail. Middlepart moderate. Scatterpart light breezes heading O.W. at 11 A.M. were ship to the N.W. Employed in washing ship. Saw a French ship steering S.E. So ends. Home Side.

Thursday June 24th.

Commenced with fresh breezes from N.W. heading S.W. Saw a ship steering S. and a ship steering E.N.E. at 10 A.M. took in sail. Middlepart fresh breezes. Scatterpart the same heading S.W. S.E. So ends. Home Side.

Friday June 25th.

Commenced with fine breezes and pleasant heading S.E. Saw a ship, Brig, and a ship steering S. at 4 1/2 P.M. took ship to the W. at sunset took in Main sail and M. S.E. sail. Glow and cover in sight. Struck a porpoise and lost him. Middlepart calm. Scatterpart thick and rainy at 8 A.M. cleared away pleasant heading S. Employed in packing flour. So ends. Home Side.

Saturday June 26th.

Commenced with fine breezes from westward heading N.W. Saw porpoises at 10 A.M. took in sail. and were ship to the S.W. Middlepart fresh breezes. Scatterpart fine weather heading N.W. at 11 A.M. saw black fish. lowered the boats struck and killed one at 11 1/2 A.M. took him to the ship So ends. Home Side.

Commenced with a fine breeze from N.W. heading O.W. Employed in cutting said black fish at sunset took in sail. Middlepart moderate. Scatterpart fine weather heading O.W. at 11 A.M. took ship to the S. Saw a point. So ends. Home Side.

Monday June 28th.

Commenced with fine breezes from N.W. heading S.W. Saw porpoises at sunset took in sail. Middlepart cloudy. Scatterpart fine weather heading O.W. Employed in boiling our black fish nothing in sight. So ends. Home Side.

243.

Tuesday June 29th.

Commenced with pleasant weather and breezes from N.W. steering N.W. at sunset took in sail. Middlepart pleasant. Scatterpart the same steering S.W. Employed in various jobs. So ends. Home Side.

Wednesday June 30th.

Commenced with beautiful weather and moderate steering S.W. Saw porpoises. Employed in setting up shades at sunset took in sail. Middlepart fine weather. Scatterpart the same Employed in coopers bread at 8 A.M. finished. So ends. Home Side.
