

Journal of a whaling voyage on board the good

294. Thursday Aug 27th 1852.
Commenced with cloudy weather and fresh breezes from westward steering S by E. At sunset took in sail and luffed to the wind, one sail in sight. Middle and Scatterpart fresh breezes heading S by E. Employed in stowing oil between decks. Caught a turtle. So ends.
Lat 37.15. N. Long 151. 25. W. Home Side

295. Friday Aug 30th.
Commenced with fresh breezes from N. N. E. heading S by E. At sunset took in sail and wore ship to the N. Middlepart fresh breezes. Scatterpart the same heading S. E. at 7 1/2 A.M. lowered for black fish. So ends.
Lat 37.28. N. Long 151. 55. W. Home Side

296. Saturday Aug 31st.
Commenced with fresh breezes from S. E. heading S. E. At sunset took in sail and wore ship to the N. N. W. Middle and Scatterparts moderate heading S by E. So ends.
Lat 37.32. N. Home Side

297. Sunday Aug 2nd.
Commenced with calms at sunset took in sail and wore ship. Middlepart calm. Scatterpart light breezes steering N. E. saw a hawk. So ends.
Lat 38. 10. N. Long 152. 00. W. Home Side

298. Monday Aug 3rd.
Commenced with fine weather and light breezes from S. steering S. E. at sunset took in sail. saw grampass. Middlepart pleasant. at 2 A.M. luffed to the wind with the main yard aback. Scatterpart fine weather. Steered N. E. saw a Brig. So ends.
Home Side

299. Tuesday Aug 24th 1852.
Commenced with light breezes from N. E. steering N. E. at sunset took in sail. Middlepart moderate. Scatterpart fresh breezes from N. E. with rain. Employed in breaking out water forward and stowing it in the after hold. So ends this day.

300. Wednesday Aug 25th.
Commenced with fresh breezes from N. E. heading S. E. Employed in stowing of the after hold, and between decks forward. At 2 P.M. saw black fish did not lower. At sunset took in sail. Middlepart fresh breezes. Scatterpart the same at 7 A.M. wore for black fish caught none. at 8 A.M. saw the island of Flores bearing S by E. distant 40 miles. So ends.
Lat 39. 21. N. Long 152. 00. W. Home Side

301. Thursday Aug 26th.
Commenced with moderate breezes from S. E. heading S. Middlepart moderate. Scatterpart the same. Saw a part of a vessel's quarter covered a boat and went to it and caught some fish. So ends.
Lat 40. 11. N. Home Side

302. Friday Aug 27th.
Commenced with light air and calm. All in sight at sunset took in sail heading to the N. Middlepart pleasant. Scatterpart the same. at daylight backed ship to the S. E. & sail in sight. at 8 A.M. saw the island of Flores bearing S. E. distant 70 miles and the island of Comore bearing S. E. distant 65 miles. So ends.
