

Journal of a whaling voyage on board the good

303. Saturday Aug 28th 1853.
Commenced with fine breezes from E.N.E. heading in for the islands of Flores a Whip and a bit in sight. at 5 P.M. tacked of shore. Middlepart pleasant Scatterpart the same. heading in for the islands of Idles in sight. So ends

304. Sunday Aug 29th.
Commenced with fine breezes from E.N.E. heading in between the islands of Idles and Corvo. Spoke the brig Lamona. Idles. of Sag. at. Owers. out clean at 3 P.M. tacked ship off shore distant from Idles 8 mls. at 4 P.M. exchanged signals with the ship Garland of New Bedford. At anchor took in sail. Middlepart fresh breezes and squally. Scatterpart fresh breezes. Standing for Corvo at meridian hove to off the track a boat came off with some fruit to sell. So ends. (Home Side)

305. Monday Aug 30th.
Commenced with fresh breezes lying off and on Corvo in company with the Bark Red Fox. Spomer of New Bedford, 16 mths. out 450 lbs of sperm. at 3 P.M. spoke the ship Antarctic. Bradbury of N.B. 5 mths out 15 lbs of sperm. went on board and got some letters the first I have received since I left home Middlepart light airs. Scatterpart the same heading to the S in company with the Antarctic. Other sails in sight. So ends. (Home Side)

306. Tuesday Aug 31st.
Commenced with light breezes from E.N.E. heading S. the Antarctic dropping astern. at dark took in sail. Middlepart light airs and calm. Scatterpart the same. Employed in getting up chocks. Flores and 3 sails in sight
Sat 38. 4. N. (Home Side)

Bark Atlantic.

307. Wednesday Sept 1st 1853.
Commenced with light breezes from N.W. steering E.S.E. Employed in getting up chocks. at dark took in sail Middlepart fresh breezes. Scatterpart the same. at daylight saw Frigate bearing E.S.E. distant 50 mls at 10 A.M. spoke the ship Andrews Bettle of New Bedford 15 mths out 330 lbs of sperm. So ends 15 sails in sight. (Home Side)

308. Thursday Sept 2nd.
Commenced with fine breezes steering in for Brazil at 3 P.M. came to anchor in 10 fathoms of water. went on shore and got a fine lot of letters. and very acceptable they were Middlepart pleasant. Scatterpart the same. Employed in breaking out the fore hold. (Home Side)

309. Friday Sept 3rd.
Commenced with fine weather sent a raft of casks ashore for water. Middlepart pleasant. Scatterpart the same. Employed in getting off a raft of water and stowing it away. Sent 40 lbs of sperm oil of shore. So ends (Home Side)

310. Saturday Sept 4th.
Commenced with fine weather got off a raft of water and started it into the tanks and sent the casks ashore. Middlepart fresh breezes from N.W. Scatterpart the same with a heavy squall. sent down main royal and top gallant yards and let go the Starboard Tackler (Home Side)

311. Sunday Sept 5th.
Commenced with fresh breezes and clear weather. got off a raft of water and stowed it below. Middlepart squally Scatterpart the same. hove up the Starboard Tackler and sent the watch ashore. So ends
