357. Thursday Oct 21st 1852.
Commences with equally weather and rain. heading
N.W. Employed in capping main rigging between
Middlesbrough and Pleasant. Butterpart calm.
Employed in breaking out between decks and starting
fresh water. So ends 1 sail in sight. Home Side.
Lat 6.50. N. Dist 21. mls. Long 21.50. W.

358. Friday Oct 22nd.
Commences with fine weather and calm. Employed
in stowing off between decks at 4 P.M. finished.
Middlesbrough calm Butterpart the same. Employed
in coopers casks and setting up jib gags at 11
A.M. looked for black fish caught none. So ends
4 sails in sight. Home Side.
Lat 6.38. N. Dist 17. mls. Long 22.05. W.

359. Saturday Oct 23rd.
Commences with light breezes heading N.W. Employed
in seizing off main rigging and coopers casks.
Middlesbrough equally and rain. Butterpart the same.
So ends 3 sails in sight. Home Side.
Lat 6.06. N. Dist 33. mls. Long 22.17. W.

360. Sunday Oct 24th.
Commences with equally rainy weather. at 4 P.M.
saw a Bark Steady N.W. Middlesbrough and Butterpart
the same. 3 sails in sight. So ends. Home Side.
Lat 5.16. N. Dist 47. mls.

361. Monday Oct 25th.
Commences with rainy equally weather. 3 sails in sight
Middlesbrough rain. Butterpart pleasant. Employed in
various jobs. So ends 3 sails in sight. Home Side.
Lat 4.47. N. Dist 30. mls.
Long by bar 21.13. W.

Bark Atlantic. Bound to the River Rio de Janeiro.

362. Tuesday Oct 26th 1852.
Commences with fine weather and light air steering
Employed variously. (I wish I was where I was a
year ago this eve.) Saw a sulphur bottom cock. Middlesbrough
fine breezes. Butterpart the same heading N.W. W.
Employed in ripping up an old topsail. at 10 P.M.
Changed signals with an American Bark. So ends
Lat 3.58. N. Dist 69. mls. Long 23.00. W.
Home Side.

363. Wednesday Oct 27th.
Commences with fine breezes and rain. heading N.W.
at 2 P.M. tacked ship to N.W. at 5 P.M. tacked to
the N.W. Employed in ripping an old sail. Middlesbrough
fresh breezes. Butterpart the same heading N.W. W.
Saw a ship heading N.W. So ends. Home Side.
Lat 2.23. N. Dist 142. mls. Long 24.50. W.

364. Thursday Oct 28th.
Commences with fresh breezes from N heading N.W. W.
Middlesbrough fresh breezes. Butterpart the same from N.W.
heading N.W. Employed in various jobs. So ends.
Lat 1.40. N. Dist 132. mls. Long 26.00. W.
Home Side.

365. Friday Oct 29th.
Commences with fine breezes from N.W. heading N.W.
Middlesbrough fresh breezes. Butterpart the same heading N.W.
passed 2 Barks one heading N.W. the other C. So ends
Lat 1.57. N. Dist 180. mls. Long 27.40. W.
Home Side.

366. Saturday Oct 30th.
Commences with fresh breezes from N.W. heading N.W. W.
Middlesbrough pleasant. at 10 P.M. saw a Bark Steady
N.W. Butterpart fresh breezes heading N.W. W. 1 sail
in sight. So ends. Home Side.
Lat 4.57. N. Dist 205. mls. Long 29.17. W.
