375. Monday Nov 8th 1852.

Commenced with fine trade breezes from N.E. steering N.W. Middleport fresh trades and cloudy. Scatterport the same and smoky weather steering N.W. Employed in ships duty. Saw a clipper ship steering N.W. to end. Home Side.
Lat 33.37. S. Dist 174. mls. Long 40.15. W. Chr 40. 12. (M. Sun 40. 23. W.)

376. Tuesday Nov 9th.

Commenced with fresh trades from N.E. Employed in ships duty. At 4 P.M. wind N.W. heading N.E. At 6 P.M. tacked ship to the N.W. and a big steering N.E. Middleport pleasant. a Bark in sight. Scatterport the same heading N.W. by N. Employed in ships duty. To end. Home Side.
Lat 34.43. S. Dist 175. mls. Long 40.50. W.

377. Wednesday Nov 10th.

Commenced with light breezes from N.E. heading N.W. Employed in ships duty. 1 sail in sight. Middleport moderate. Scatterport light breezes steering N.W. by N. At 6 A.M. saw 3 spots luffed to the wind but did not see anything more of them. At 8 A.M. kept off to her course. To end. 1 sail in sight. Home Side.
Lat 36.11. S. Dist 105. mls. Long 41.55. W. 42.20. W.

378. Thursday Nov 11th.

Commenced with fine breezes from E. steering N.W. by S. Employed in ships duty. 1 sail in sight. Middleport moderate and foggy weather. Scatterport smoky weather steering N.W. by S. Employed in ships duty. Saw Albatrosses and a large turtle. To end. Home Side.
Lat 38.29. S. Dist 91. mls. Long 44.17. W.

Bark Atlanta. Bound to the River Rio de la Plata.

Friday Nov 12th 1852.

379. Commenced with thick weather and light breezes from N.E. steering N.W. by S. Employed in ships duty. Middleport moderate and foggy. Scatterport foggy and fresh breezes from N.W. heading N.E. at 6 A.M. wind N.E. tacked ship to N.W. and took in light sails at meridian strong breezes double reefed the topsails to end. Home Side.
Dist 68 miles.

380. Saturday Nov 13th.

Commenced with strong breezes from N.E. heading N.W. by S. 1 sail in sight. Middleport variable. Scatterport light breezes steering N.W. Employed in ships duty. To end. Home Side.
Lat 39.13. S. Dist 125. mls. Long 45.44. W.

381. Sunday Nov 14th.

Commenced with fine weather and breezes from N.E. steering N.W. Saw hump backs. Middleport pleasant. Scatterport the same. steering N.W. and hump backs and jumpers. To end. Home Side.
Lat 39.30. S. Dist 156. mls. Long 47.09. W.

382. Monday Nov 15th.

Commenced with fine breezes from N.E. steering N.W. by S. Employed in sending down N.E. yard and sail saw turtles. Middle and Scatterport fine breezes. Employed in sending down fore top gallant mast and main royal. Saw hump backs and porpoises to end. Home Side.
Lat 35.35. S. Dist 144 mls.
