

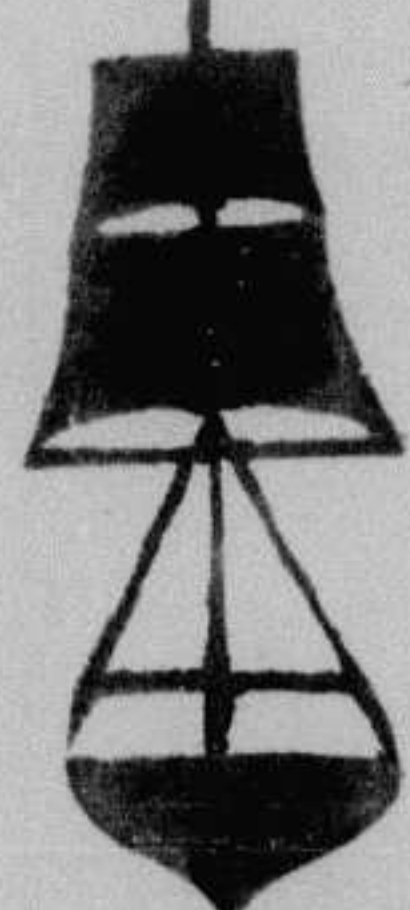

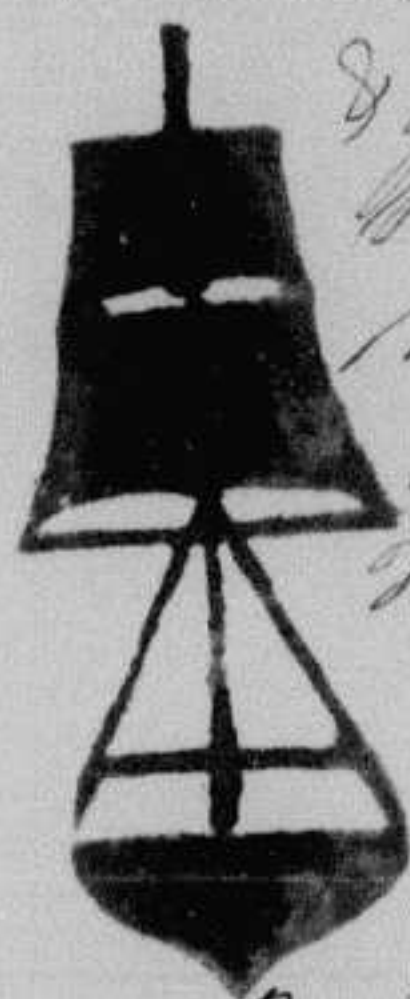

2 N by W W by N 1 Commence with fair weather and moderate
4 N by E N by W 1 breeze ship steering by the wind with all
6 sails set at 1 P.M. struck ship a ship in
8 sight at 8 toh in Soffall's out sail &
10 Double reefed the Topsails the wind increasing
12 Mid Part a gale of wind at 10 toh in Main sail
2 & set at 12 here the ship to under close
4 Haul main Topsail & storm sails latter part
6 Moderate breeze and fair weather set close
8 Haul Topsail and main sail spoke ship
10 Governor of Falmouth this day
12 Lat by 52° 36' S
Long " 79° 50' W
