 10 Wby S. E. N. E. Wind fresh breeze & fair weather
 12 latter part pleasant the water employed
 14 in repairing sail repaired Main top gallant
 16 Sail & sent it again thus end
 Lat by Obs 20° 52' N
 Long " " 174° 13' W

 1 Wby S. E. N. E. Commenced with a fine breeze & pleasant
 4 weather Ship Steering a Course with all
 6 sail set the water employed in repairing
 8 sail repaired Main top gallant sent at
 10 4 P.M. on board the Main top sail sent
 12 a netter one in its place Wind part
 14 moderate latter part a fresh breeze
 16 and cloudy attended with moderate rain
 18 thus end
 Lat by Obs 20° 50' N
 Long " " 178° 30' W

H. H. H. Course Wind S.W. Remarks on board Sunday May 13th
 1 Wby S. N. E. Commenced with a fresh breeze & fair
 4 weather Ship Steering a Course Wind part
 6 gradually with thunder and rain at 1 P.M.
 8 took a heavy squall from the Westward
 10 took in all sail split the Main Royal
 12 at 3 P.M. Ship Steering a Course again made
 14 sail accordingly latter part a light breeze
 16 and pleasant Ship with all sail set again
 18 at 4 P.M. got a Lunar Observation
 thus end
 Lat by Obs 20° 56' N
 Long " " 175° 46' W
 " " Chron 175° 44' W

 1 Wby S. E. N. E. Commenced with light air and calm pleasant
 4 weather Ship Steering a Course Wind part
 6 latter a light breeze & variable at 6 A.M.
 8 shifted over the standing sail the water employed
 10 repairing the Main Royal thus end got a
 12 Lunar Observation
 Lat by Obs 21° 30' N
 Long " " Chron 176° 06' W
 Long " " Lunar 176° 01' W
 Variation 12' East

 1 Wby S. E. N. E. Commenced with pleasant weather & moderate
 4 breeze Ship Steering a Course the water repairing
 6 Main top sail sent the Main Royal &
 8 Wind part shifted over the standing sail
 10 a light air & variable latter part
 12 light air the water variously employed
 14 thus end
 Lat by Obs 22° 14' N
 Long " " 178° 01' W

H. H. H. Course Wind S.W. Remarks on board Wednesday May 16th
 1 Wby S. E. N. E. Commenced with light air and pleasant weather
 4 Ship Steering a Course all sail set the water
 6 variously employed Wind part near calm
 8 latter part a light air Ship by the wind
 10 thus end the water repairing Main top
 12 standing sail
 Lat by Obs 23° 10' N
 Long " " 179° 59' W
