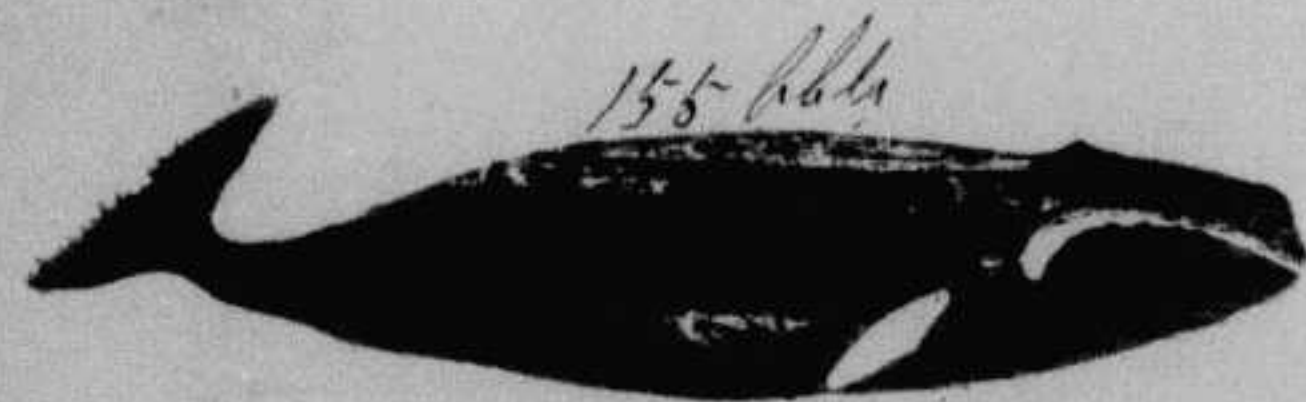


Ship Sailed to cruising for Whale Near The coast of

Remarks on board Friday June 24th

Commence with a light air from the Westward
and fair weather. At 1 P.M. under all sail on
the ship at 3 hours our boat for a whale
got fast at 8 P.M. took him a long side mid part
lying by the whale latter part fine weather
and light air at 4 P.M. commenced butting the
whale at 12 finished thus on

Commence with pleasant weather and a light
air from S.W. ship under easy sail heading
N.W. by E. Employed in boiling mid part
moderate and foggy latter part fair weather
a moderate breeze from the Westward ship by the
wind heading N.W. thus on

Remarks on board Sunday June 26th

Commence with fine weather a moderate
breeze from the Westward Employed in boiling
lower or best for a whale but without success
mid part lying under easy sail heading N.W. by E
latter part the weather haze and moderate
Employed as above thus on. Ship whole under
all & main topgallant sail heading N.W. by E

Commence with a moderate breeze from the Westward
the weather haze ship with main topgallant
sail at heading N.W. by E Employed in boiling
at 10 P.M. finished boiling mid part lying under
easy sail latter part calm & foggy Employed
in moving down side thus on

Remarks on board Tuesday June 26th

Commence with calm and the weather haze Employed
in moving down side at 7 P.M. finished mid part
calm latter part a light air the weather Employed
in sitting up side ship & washing down thus on
calm & thick weather No sail

Lat by account 46° 30' N
Long " " 158° 30' East

Remarks on board Wednesday June 27th

Commence with calm & thick haze weather
the weather Employed in scraping bone
mid part a moderate breeze from the Westward
ship heading to the South under easy sail
latter part a fresh breeze ship by the wind
main topgallant sail at heading N.W. by E
End variable weather Employed sitting up side
thus on
