

Ship Arrived at cruising for Sperm Whale
Remarks on board Friday Feb 15th 1850

commenced with light air
& calm the weather variable ship working to the
waterward mid part as above latter to fine weather and
a moderate breeze from the N.E. ship steering S.W. thus
end.

Remarks on board Saturday Feb 16th Lat 4° N Long 165° 29' E

commenced with a moderate
breeze from the N.E. ship steering S.W. mid part by the wind
heading S.E. latter part fine weather ship steering
W.S.W. thus end.

Remarks on board Sunday Feb 17th

commenced with a moder-
ate breeze from the E. ship steering W.S.W. all sail
set at 8 P.M. took in sail before the ship by the wind
heading S.E. latter to a fresh breeze from the N.E. ship
steering W.S.W. thus end.

Remarks on Monday Feb 18th Lat 5° 7' S Long 164° 58' E

commenced with a fresh breeze from
the N.E. ship steering W.S.W. at 8 P.M. took in sail
mid part. Specially ship by the wind heading N.W. by E.
latter to fair weather ship steering S.W. thus end excepting
in making a haul aft.

Remarks on board Tuesday Feb 19th Lat 8° 33' S Long 163° 41' E

first part a fresh breeze from the
N.E. & fair weather ship steering S.W. all sail out.
mid part by the wind heading S.W. by E. under easy sail.
latter part a strong breeze & squally ship by the wind
heading S.W. by E. and raining no sail.

Remarks on Wednesday Feb 20th Lat by account 10° N Long 163° 00' E

commenced with a strong breeze
from the N.E. & squally ship heading S.W. by the wind
at 6 P.M. were ship & took in sail mid part heading S.E.
latter to ship by the wind heading S.W. by E. thus
end.

Lat 5° S Long 162° 10' E

Commanded by Warrant M. Sherman
Remarks on board Thursday Feb 21st 1850

commenced with a moderate
breeze from the N.E. ship by the wind heading S.W. at 8 P.M.
took in sail mid part heading as above latter to moderate ship
with all sail set heading S.E. thus end.

Remarks on Friday Feb 22nd Lat 2° 50' N Long 161° 57' E

commenced with a moderate breeze from the
N.E. ship steering by the wind heading S.E. with all sail
set mid part under easy sail latter part all sail
set steering by the wind heading S.W. thus end.

Lat 13° N Long 161° 42' E

Remarks on board Saturday Feb 23rd

commenced with a light
breeze from the N.E. ship all sail out by the wind heading
N.W. by E. mid part under easy sail latter part all
sail set heading S.E. thus end.

Remarks on board Sunday Feb 24th Lat 9° 10' N Long 161° 07' E

commenced with a moderate
breeze from the N.E. ship by the wind all sail set heading
N.W. by E. mid part carrying sail the wind variable at
8 P.M. shifted ship to the Eastward latter part some squally
ship by the wind heading N.W. thus end.

Lat 2° 30' N Long 160° 47' E

Remarks on board Monday Feb 25th 1850

commenced with variable
winds & weather ship with all sail set heading S.W. by the
wind at 2 P.M. took ship to the Eastward at 4 took back again
mid part squally with frequent rain ship heading S.W.
latter to a strong breeze the light sails in thus end.

Remarks on Tuesday Feb 26th Lat 2° 33' N Long 160° 43' E

commenced with a fresh breeze from
the N.E. ship heading S.E. the light sails in at 8 P.M.
took ship mid part heading S.W. by E. latter part a
strong breeze from the N.E. ship heading S.W. by the
wind thus end.

Lat 3° 50' N Long 161° 40' E
