 12 7 " again the weather kind of hazy this

 2 5 NW " and hazy weather ship with all sail at
 6 5 " steering a course at 7 P.M. when
 8 7 " light. Whales took in the fore part of the
 10 7 " ship by the wind. Wind lost a fresh breeze
 12 7 " constant. Latter part a light breeze. The
 2 7 " fair weather at daylight. Wind lost a
 6 5 " fresh breeze. Latter part the wind then
 8 5 " end
 10 5 " Lat 53° 40' N
 12 5 " Long 170° 10' E

 2 5 NW 8 W Commenced with fair weather and a
 2 5 NW " moderate breeze ship by the wind all

 10 5 " a strong breeze. Latter part
 12 5 " fresh gale at 10 P.M. Double
 2 5 " reefed the fore sail. Wind lost a
 6 5 " fresh breeze. Latter part the wind then
 8 5 " end

 8 7 " at 7 P.M. in the fore & mizzen fore sails. The
 10 7 " reefed the main sail. Wind lost a fresh breeze
 12 7 " reefed main fore sail & fore sail. Latter part
 2 7 " the weather is again rather more moderate
 6 5 " at 10 P.M. at the fore sail double reefed. Wind
 8 5 " lost a fresh breeze. Latter part the wind then
 10 5 " end
 12 5 " Lat by account 53° 44' N
 Long " 171° 18' E
 Variation 1 point E

 8 7 " of the fore sail a heavy squall. Wind lost
 10 7 " a moderate breeze. Latter part
 12 7 " a light air and fair weather
 2 7 " ship steering a course the watch
 6 5 " employed in repairing the fore sail. Wind
 8 5 " lost a fresh breeze. Latter part the wind then
 10 5 " end
