Remarks on board Friday May 10th

Commenced with strong weather in fresh breeze from the S.W. ship steering a course of N.E. at 8 AM. In all sail but 1000 fathoms. Under topsails & fore sails. Mid part running at 10. Latter part wind & weather so along at 10 AM was ship and at the Kamtschatka ship sailing at 10 AM. Lat by account 58° 53' N Long by 174° 58' E

Saturday May 11th

Commenced with thick weather and fresh breeze from the S.W. ship steering a course of S.E. at 10 AM. Under topsails & fore sails. Mid part running at 10. Latter part wind & weather so along at 10 AM was ship and at the Kamtschatka ship sailing at 10 AM. Lat by account 58° 53' N Long by 174° 58' E

Remarks on board Sunday May 12th

Commenced with a fresh breeze from the S.W. ship steering a course of S.W. at 10 AM. Under topsails & fore sails. Mid part running at 10. Latter part wind & weather so along at 10 AM was ship and at the Kamtschatka ship sailing at 10 AM. Lat by account 58° 53' N Long by 174° 58' E

Sunday May 13th

Commenced with light air and calm ship with all sail at steering a course of N.E. at 10 AM. Under topsails & fore sails. Mid part running at 10. Latter part wind & weather so along at 10 AM was ship and at the Kamtschatka ship sailing at 10 AM. Lat by account 58° 53' N Long by 174° 58' E

Remarks on board Tuesday May 14th

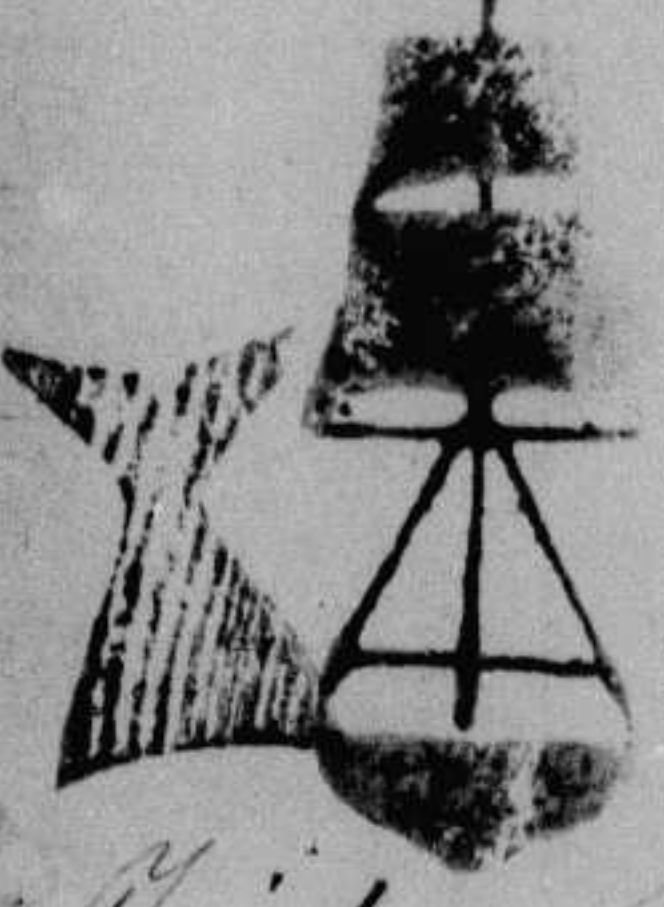
Commenced with fine weather and a moderate breeze from the S.W. ship steering a course of N.E. at 8 AM. Saw sperm whales. Mid part running under easy sail. Latter part variable weather at 10 AM. Under topsails & fore sails. Mid part running at 10. Latter part wind & weather so along at 10 AM was ship and at the Kamtschatka ship sailing at 10 AM. Lat by account 58° 53' N Long by 174° 58' E

Wednesday May 15th

Commenced with a moderate breeze from the S.W. ship steering a course of N.E. at 10 AM. Under topsails & fore sails. Mid part running at 10. Latter part wind & weather so along at 10 AM was ship and at the Kamtschatka ship sailing at 10 AM. Lat by account 58° 53' N Long by 174° 58' E

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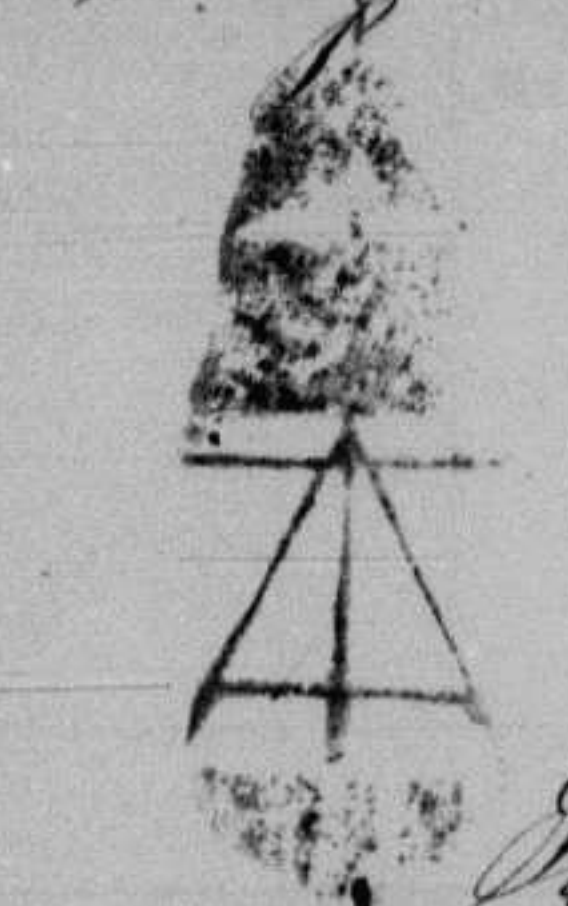
Remarks on board Thursday May 16th



Commenced with a light air from the S.W. and a thick fog ship lying with main yard aback at 8 PM. The fog lifted up ship & ship at 9 PM. Saw field ice and a sperm whale. Toward 10 PM. Mid part running at 10. Latter part wind & weather so along at 10 AM was ship and at the Kamtschatka ship sailing at 10 AM. Lat by account 58° 53' N Long by 174° 58' E

Friday May 17th

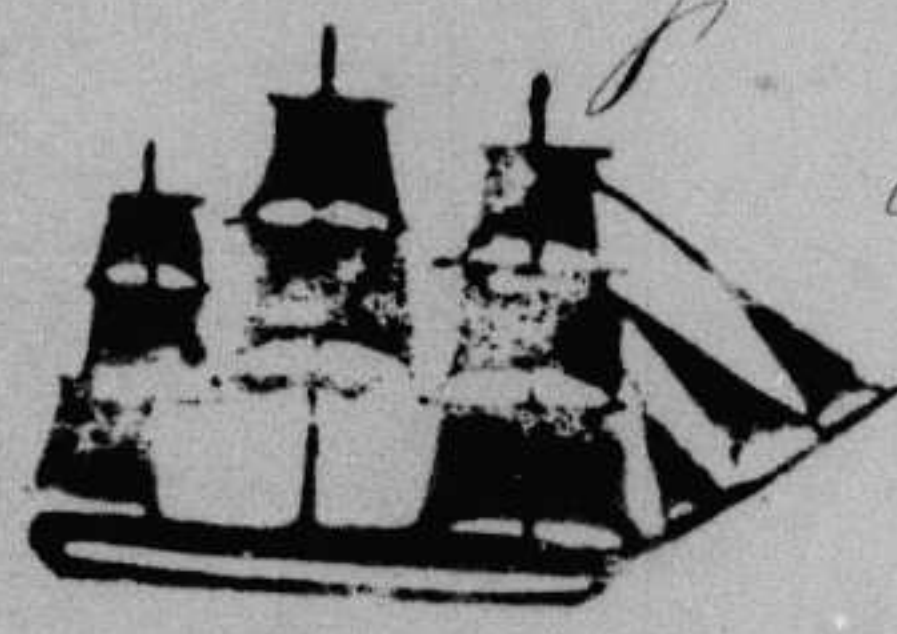
Commenced with calm weather something of a swell on ship in sight. Mid part calm. Latter part a light air from the S.W. saw abundance of ice and the boat off in chase of a whale. Lat by account 58° 53' N Long by 174° 58' E



Saturday May 18th

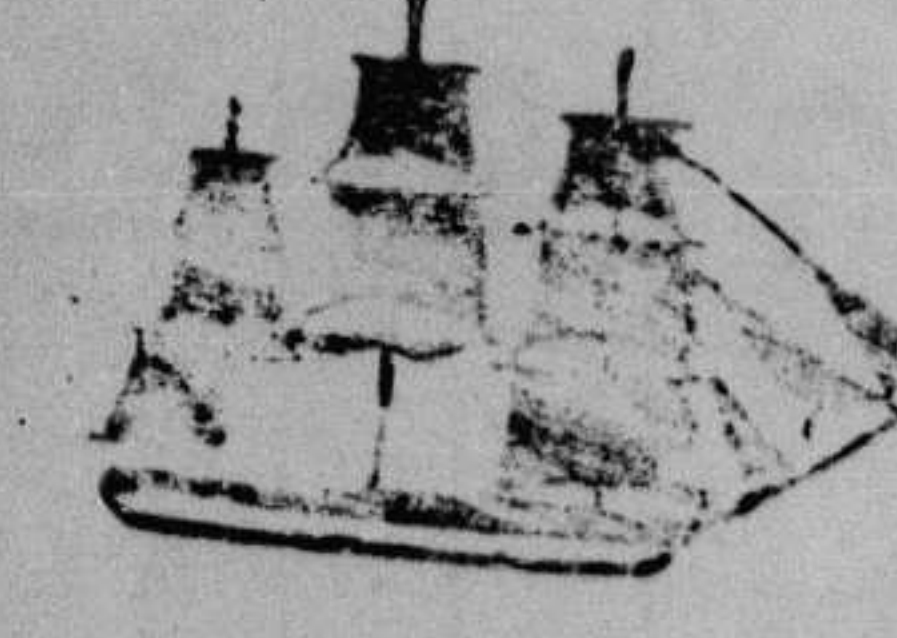
Commenced with light air and calm. 18 ships in sight. Saw whale at 6 PM. Spoke ship Kamtschatka & Blenheim. Mid part calm. Latter part a light air from the Eastward. Ship working to the N. thus end of ship in sight. Lat by account 58° 53' N Long by 174° 58' E

Sunday May 19th



Commenced with a moderate breeze from the Eastward. Ship steering to the N. with all sail set. The weather fine at 7 PM. Spoke the ship Splendid of Capt. Spring. Mid part a light air. Latter part a moderate breeze from the S.W. ship with all sail at steering a course of N.E. at 10 AM. Lowered or hoisted for a whale thus end. Lat by account 58° 53' N Long by 174° 58' E

Remarks on board Monday May 20th



Commenced with a fresh breeze from the S.W. ship with all sail set. Steering a course of N.E. at 8 PM. Spoke ship Express of New Bedford. Mid part the topsails & fore sails. Latter part pleasant weather saw abundance of ice and one whale thus end. Lat by account 58° 53' N Long by 174° 58' E

Tuesday May 21st



Commenced with pleasant weather employed in whaling got fast to a whale got one boat stow lost on line. Mid part & latter a strong breeze employed in whaling saw a number of them a number of ships in sight saw 5 of them take whales thus end. Lat by account 58° 53' N Long by 174° 58' E
