

Ship Nimrod In The Arctic Ocean
Monday Aug the 12th

Commenced with a strong breeze from the N^W & a snow storm employed in boiling Minst Part & latter fair weather employed in chasing Whales & boiling them end

Lat 84° 12' N Long 172° 40' W

Tuesday Aug 13th

Commenced with fair weather employed in boiling three Boats off in chase of Whales Minst Part fresh gale from the Eastward and Stormy latter Part more in even saw a number of Whales got part to one & he took the Line and the Boats in chase of the Whale with the Line to him the weather stormy

Wednesday Aug 14th

 Commenced with stormy weather and fresh breeze from the Eastward three Boats off in chase of a Whale with a Line to him got lost to him got him to the ship at 4 P.M. so rugged concluded to let him be along till next morning employed in boiling latter Part made whale out cut in the Whale & commenced storing down lat this end

Lat 84° 25' N

Thursday Aug 15th

There is heavy fair weather First Part all hands employed in storing down oil Minst Part the whale latter Part all hands in storing & boiling thus end

Lat 84° 19' N Long 175° 00' W

Friday Aug the 16th

Commenced with variable weather frequent rain the wind from the Eastward employed in boiling & storing down oil Minst Part stormy latter Part fine weather employed as above thus end

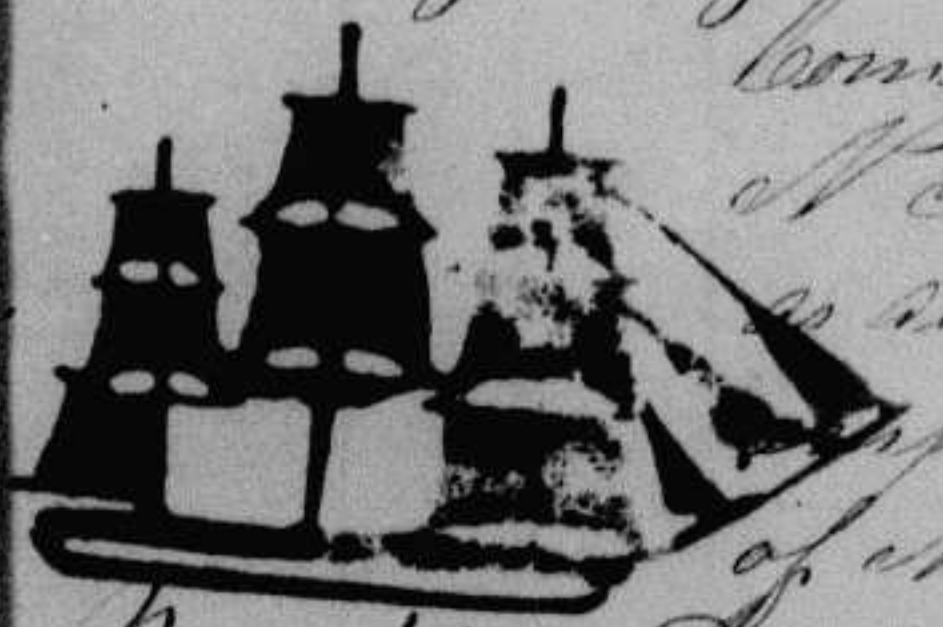
Lat 84° 50' N

Saturday Aug 17th

Commenced with fine weather & light air from the Eastward employed in boiling & storing down Minst Part the weather as above latter Part now the same employed in boiling only thus end two ships in sight

Sunday Aug the 18th



Commenced with fine weather and light air from the N^W this a steady to the Eastward employed in boiling Minst Part a strong breeze from the Eastward fine weather fine employed in casing pipes thus end spoke the ship Brockline of Melbourn

Lat 84° 10' N Long 173° 30' W

Monday Aug 19th

Commenced with pleasant weather and a moderate breeze from the ship heading to the Eastward & this in sight employed in casing pipes Minst Part a fresh breeze latter Part the wind fair all hands employed in storing down oil only thick weather

Tuesday Aug 20th

Commenced with moderate breeze & variable weather employed in storing down Minst Part storing oil moderate breeze from the Eastward latter Part fair weather a number of Whales in sight saw our boats & got rid of them thus end

Lat 84° 30' N Long 174° 00' W

Wednesday Aug 21st

First Part the weather fine cut in our whale Minst Part a strong breeze from the Eastward employed in clearing away head & boiling & latter Part strong gales saw two ships a number of Whales thus end no fog this day

Thursday Aug 22nd

Commenced with fresh gales and bad weather employed in boiling or storing our whale is very poor that what one whale more in order to fill a plenty of them in sight Minst Part the weather fair latter Part calm & clear weather thus end

Lat 84° 14' N Long 174° 00' W

Friday Aug 23rd

Commenced with fine weather and moderate breeze employed in boiling saw a number of Whales got near enough to lower for them came in foggy Minst Part a fresh breeze & cloudy latter Part a strong breeze and clear weather a plenty of Whales in sight and the Boats off in chase of Whales
