

Ship Nimrod In The Arctic Ocean
Saturday Aug 24th

Commence with a strong breeze from the Eastward & fair weather the boat fast to a whale at 4 AM got him to the ship & sent him in a plenty of Whales in sight but we want no more this whale will fill all of our cask we are in hopes to see a ship in order to get some cash if not we shall have to throw away a part of him. Mid Part employ'd in boiling Latt'd Part thick most of the time the watch employ'd in starting bread & saw a ship to the windward but it came in thick could not keep run of her. ends moderate

Sunday Aug 25th

Commence with moderate weather and thick fog the watch variously employ'd such as mustering cask & to put oil in Mid Part steering to Cour. & C. 20 a moderate breeze from the N. employ'd in boiling Latt'd Part a moderate breeze from the N. employ'd with all sail set steering S. S. E. over all ship's & hope to see a ship in order to get cash but without success this ends

Monday Aug 26th

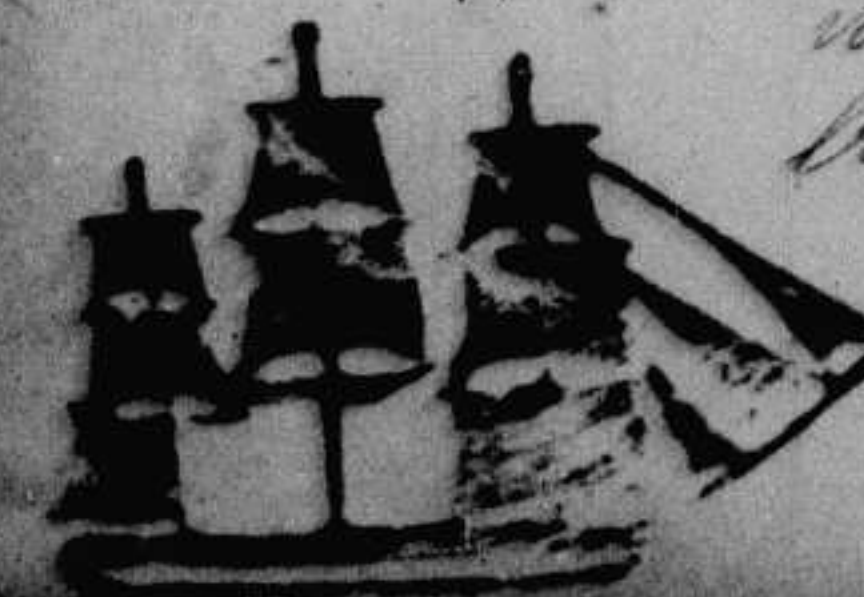
Commence with a light air from the N. ship with all sail set steering S. S. E. employ'd in boiling and coopersing oil for starting Mid Part as above Latt'd Part moderate at 10 AM put out the fire pitch'd the blubber on deck & commenced steering down this ends no obs

Tuesday Aug 27th

Commence with a light air and foggy this with all sail set steering S. S. E. employ'd in steering down and mustering cask & to find oil in have got about 40 lbs of blubber on deck and no cask to put it in Mid Part as above Latt'd fine weather and a fresh breeze from the N. ship steering S. S. E. employ'd as above this ends Lat 67° 00' Long 170° 00'

Wednesday Aug 28th

Commence with fine weather and a fresh breeze from the N. ship with all sail set steering S. S. E. finish'd steering down spoke the ship & pupbrats got some cask & commenced boiling again Mid Part as above Latt'd Part a strong breeze the land in sight ends the East Cape bearing N 70° W
Lat 66° 02' Long 167° 00'



Bound off Full Towards The Sandwich Isles
Thursday Aug 29th

Commence with fresh breezes from the N. ship with all sail set steering S. S. E. along with the land variation three points Eastward Lat 2° 10' finish'd boiling the watch employ'd in coopersing & washing up oil & saw got on deck 70 lbs of oil 30 lbs of water flour & a cask load of other trash & ship in sight all a steering off. Mid Part as above Latt'd Part more moderate the watch employ'd in scraping some this ends the land about 15 miles off ship steering S. S. W the wind off
Lat 64° 18' Long 172° 20'

Friday Aug 30th

Commence with moderate & pleasant weather ship with all sail set steering S. S. W the land about 15 off the watch employ'd in scraping some Mid Part a fresh breeze from the N. steering S. S. W Latt'd Part variable weather the watch employ'd in scraping some this ends
Lat 63° 00' Long 174° 50'

Saturday Aug 31st

Commence with a strong breeze from the N. & squally ship with all sail set steering S. S. W the watch employ'd in making a bon fire on deck & starting away some have got to cask & ready on deck Mid Part as above Latt'd do more moderate the weather fine ends the watch variously employ'd
Lat 61° 15' Long 178° 20'

Sunday Sept 1st

Commence with pleasant weather and a fine breeze from the N. ship with all sail set steering S. S. E. the watch variously employ'd Mid Part as above Latt'd pleasant & ship in sight at the steering oil at 10 AM got a Lunar obs this ends steering S. S. E. Long 179° 50' Lat 59° 10' Long by Lunar 178° 50'

Monday Sept 2nd

Commence with pleasant weather light air & variable steering S. S. E. at 10 AM took in the stinging sea's brand up the fore the wind S. S. W ship heading S. S. W Mid Part & Latt'd a fresh breeze from the S. S. E. and thick weather ship heading N. ship allant sail in this ends no obs
Lat by account 62° 00' Long 180° 00'
