2 1/2 S.E. S.W. commence with a fresh breeze & fair weather ship with all sail set steering a course the watch employed in washing Bone found our bone very dirty. Mid Part wind & weather as above ship with Bone forward steering sail at Latter Part a fresh breeze ship with steering sail at below & aloft the watch employed in washing Bone this end

Remarks on board Saturday Sept 24th

2 1/2 S.E. S.W. commence with fair weather and light breeze ship steering a course with steering sail set the watch employed in washing Bone drying it & stowing it away. Mid Part as above Latter Part light air and calm employed as above at 10 o'clock got a Lunar Obs this end

Remarks on board Sunday Sept 25th

2 1/2 S.E. S.W. commence with fine weather and calm the watch employed in washing Bone and stowing it away at 4 P.M. a light air sprang up Mid Part a moderate breeze and a heavy swell on from the S.W. ship by the wind all sail set Latter Part a fresh breeze and squally ship by the wind the light sail in all but Main top gallant sail got a Lunar Obs this end a ship in sight

Remarks on board Monday Sept 26th

2 1/2 S.E. S.W. commence with fresh gale and squally weather ship with Main top gallant sail set steering a course a ship in sight ahead Mid Part as above Latter Part a fresh breeze & a rain storm at 1 o'clock the wind changed suddenly and ship steering a course with steering sail set the watch employed in washing Bone a ship in sight no Obs this day

Long " Lunar 152° 38' W
Long " Lunar 152° 08' W
Variation 12° 14' East

Remarks on board Tuesday Sept 27th

2 1/2 S.E. S.W. commence with a fresh breeze and a rain storm ship steering a course with all sail set steering sail below & aloft the watch employed in washing Bone at 6 P.M. squally the ship George of Fairhaven Mid Part moderate and fine weather Latter Part clear weather employed in drying Bone & stowing it away a ship in sight this end
Lat by Obs 30° 18' N
Long " 155° 00' W

Remarks on board Wednesday Sept 28th

2 1/2 S.E. S.W. commence with a fresh breeze & fair weather ship steering a course with all sail set employed in washing Bone at 4 P.M. took in the steering sail & braced up the yards at 5 o'clock in the light sail being squally with a heavy swell on Mid Part as above Latter Part strong gales & squally ship by the wind the watch variously employed this end
Lat by Obs 28° 17' N
Long " 152° 10' W
