 2 S. E. S. W. commenced with fresh gales and stormy
 4 ship steering by bows under whole topsail
 6 at 2 P.M. saw a schooner by the
 8 wind on the starboard tack saw a ship
 10 steering as ourselves at 6 double reefed
 12 the fore & mizzen topsails Min Part
 strong breeze the weather fair
 latter part all sail set thus ends the
 East Point of Moore 10 miles off
 Lat by Ab 22. 40 N
 Long " " 154. 30 W

H. K. H. course Wind W. Remarks on board Monday Oct 7th
 2 S. E. S. W. commenced with a strong breeze from
 4 and fair weather ship with all sail
 6 set a ship in sight ahead Min Part
 8 as above at 1 P.M. came up with the
 10 ship & passed her at 2 P.M. took in
 12 topsail and hauled the main and
 14 black latter part strong gales & squally
 at 7 P.M. saw the East Point of Moore
 end with all sail set steering along with
 the Land
 W. S. E. S. W.

Remarks on board Tuesday Oct 8th
 commenced with fresh gales from the East
 ship with all sail set steering for the Port of Laysan
 at 4 got the Opehuas off of the bow got within 4 miles
 of the ship the wind light by a light air came up from
 the S. E. kept her off W. by S for Waianae Min Part
 moderate latter part lying off & on at Honolulu thus ends
 Wednesday Oct 9th
 commenced with strong gales from the N. W. ship lying
 off & on at Honolulu at 4 P.M. came to anchor
 close side off the reef in 13 fathoms of water Min Part
 and latter moderate at 5 P.M. got the ship under
 way at 10 came to anchor in the employment in drying Bone
 thus ends
