

Ship Arrived from the Sandwich Islands

W. H. H. Course, Wind, & Remarks on board Thursday Nov 7th

2 1/2 SE Calm commenced with a fresh breeze and a heavy swell on ship by the wind under double reefed topsails at 5 PM more moderate and the reefs put at the main topsails and light three ships in sight at mid night light air and calm latter part fresh breeze ship with all sail set the watch variously employed thus ends

SE Calm

W. H. H. Course, Wind, & Remarks on board Friday Nov 8th

2 1/2 SE Calm commenced with a strong breeze and fair weather ship with all sail set steering by the wind at 5 PM took in top gall and sails mid part fresh gale and squally at 10 PM double reefed the topsails latter part strong gale & squally ship steering by the wind thus ends a ship in sight

SE Calm

W. H. H. Course, Wind, & Remarks on board Saturday Nov 9th

2 1/2 SE Calm commenced with fresh gale and rugged ship under double reefed topsails steering by the wind at 5 PM shot the fire boat in the rearward of it and furl'd it mid part as above latter part raining and rugged ship a leaking some thus ends no obs this day

Towards Cape Horn, November 1850

W. H. H. Course, Wind, & Remarks on board Sunday Nov 10th

2 1/2 SE Calm commenced with strong gale and raining ship under double reefed topsails steering by the wind mid part more moderate not so much rain latter part the weather fair but the trade strong and a heavy sea on thus ends no obs this day

SE Calm

Variation on point Easterly

W. H. H. Course, Wind, & Remarks on board Monday Nov 11th

2 1/2 SE Calm commenced with strong breeze and calm ship by the wind under double reefed topsails mid part as above latter part fair weather more moderate let the reefs out of the topsails the watch employed in mending the fish thus ends

SE Calm

W. H. H. Course, Wind, & Remarks on board Tuesday Nov 12th

2 1/2 SE Calm commenced with fair weather and fresh breeze ship by the wind under whole topsails the watch employed in repairing & bedding fish mid part as above latter part the weather fair all sail set the watch variously employed thus ends
