Remarks on board Friday Dec 13th
 commenced with fair weather ship
 with standing sail and steering a bow
 M^{rs} Part a breeze on both
 top gallant standing sail main royal
 & latter part at 5th of m carried away
 fore topmast standing sail boom
 took in top gallant sails double
 reefed the fore & mizen topsails
 hoisted up the boats made all snug
 as possible and a gale of wind
 Lat by Obs 30° 05' S
 Long " " 145° 50' W

Remarks on board Saturday Dec 14th
 commenced a gale of wind ship steering
 a bow under double reefed topsails
 M^{rs} Part more moderate at the
 top gallant sails latter part fair
 weather ship with standing sail
 at thus end
 Lat by Obs 30° 14' S
 Long " " 145° 00' W

Remarks on board Sunday Dec 15th
 There 24 hours strong Gale first part
 fair weather ship with all
 sail at steering a bow M^{rs} Part
 standing sail for 4 or 5 a heavy swell
 on both in the want boat
 latter part much the same thus
 end
 Lat by Obs 31° 10' S
 Long " " 139° 50' W

Towards Valparaiso (Dec 18th 50)

Remarks on board Monday Dec 16th
 There 24 hours fair weather and fresh
 breeze ship steering a bow with
 all sail set at 8th of m at the stud
 ding sails latter part the water
 employed in repairing the fore
 for short standing sail thus end
 Lat by Obs 32° 40' S
 Long " " 136° 55' W

Remarks on board Tuesday Dec 17th
 There 24 hours pleasant weather first
 part light air M^{rs} Part & latter
 calm the water variously employed
 such as washing gunnars fitting
 rigging &c thus end
 Lat by Obs 33° 05' S
 Long " " 135° 20' W

Remarks on board Wednesday Dec 18th
 There 24 hours pleasant weather
 first & middle part calm latter part
 a light air ship by the wind with
 all sail set the water variously
 employed thus end
 Lat by Obs 33° 04' S
