

Ship Sirmed from Oahu to Honolulu
Sunday March 16th 1851

These 24 hours fine weather and
balm at 8th M. saw sperm whales
and the boats off in chase

Monday March 17th

Commenced calm the boats off in
chase of whales at 3 P.M. returned to the
ship Mid Part and latter a light
breeze and fine weather ship by the wind
with all sail at heading S S E the wind
from the Eastward thus ends

Lat 25° 48' S Long 148° 10' W

Tuesday March 18th

These 24 hours fine weather and
a light breeze from the S E ship by the
wind all sail at heading S S E the wind
variously employed thus ends

Lat 27° 40' S Long 148° 27'

Wednesday March 19th

Commenced with a moderate
breeze from the S E ship heading S S W
by the wind Mid Part the wind from the
S E back ship in to the Eastward
latter part a fine breeze and fair weather
in ship heading S thus ends

Lat 28° 30' S Long 147° 40'

Thursday March 20th

These 24 hours fair weather and
a moderate breeze from the S E ship by
the wind heading East all sail at the
watch variously employed thus ends

Lat 28° 44' S Long 145° 27'

Friday March 21st

Commenced with a moderate breeze
from the S E ship by the wind heading
East Mid Part light air and variable
back ship several times latter part
light air and finally into a breeze from
the S E ship heading East by the wind

Lat 29° 22' S Long 144° 38'

Cape Horn commanded by W. H. Sherman
Saturday March 22nd 1851

These 24 hours fair weather first part
a moderate breeze from the S E ship by the
wind heading East at 6 P.M. the wind headed
back off to the ship Mid Part a fresh breeze
from the Eastward ship by the wind heading
S S E fore & Mizzen top sail hauled in latter
part all sail at thus ends

Lat 30° 22' S Long

Sunday March 23rd

Commenced with a fresh breeze from the
E S ship with all sail at heading S S E Mid Part under
at latter part a fine breeze from the S E ship steering a course
S E by E with all sail at thus ends

Lat 31° 43' S Long 142° 15' W

Monday March 24th

Commenced with a fresh breeze from the S E
ship steering a course S E by E, steering S E at
Mid & latter part as before thus ends

Lat 33° 50' S

Tuesday March 25th

Commenced with thick weather and
a strong breeze from the Westward ship steering
a course S E by E all sail at Mid Part moderate
ship by the wind steering sails in heading back
course latter part variable wind and weather
at 10 P.M. the ship ends ship heading S S W
by the wind last part took a board

Lat 34° 50' S Long 140° 00' W

Wednesday March 26th

These 24 hours variable wind and weather
part of the time calm the wind varying from
S S W to S E ship working to the Eastward
all sail at thus ends

Lat 37° 27' S

Thursday March 27th

First in Mid Part of these 24 hours
a light breeze from the Eastward ship by the
wind the weather blowing latter part a
fresh breeze from the S E and stormy ship
steering S E by E thus ends

Lat 35° 44' S
