Middle part, calm. Latter part, light air
from the N.E. saw a school of Blackfish
lowered 3 boats, and caught 5, took them
alongside and hoisted them in.

Friday, Mar. 12th First part, fine weather
and strong light breezes from the N.E.
steering S.E. by S. employed Blackfishing.
Middle part, strong winds from the N.E.
steering S.E. Latter part, squally weather,
employed boiling our Blackfish.

Lat. 36° 45' Long 61° 40'

Saturday, Mar. 13th First part, fine weather
and moderate winds from the S.W.
steering S.E. Middle part, light breezes
from the N.W. steering S.E. by E. Latter part
the same, variously employed.

Lat. 37° 10' Long 68° 30'

Sunday, Mar. 14th First part, fine weather &
light breezes from the N.W. steering S.E. by
E. variously employed. Middle part & Latter
part, the same.

Lat. 37° 15' Long 60° 30'

Monday, Mar. 15th First part, fine weather
and light breezes from the N.W. steering
S.E. Middle part, moderate wind from
the S.E. steering by the wind to the
south. Latter part, the same, foggy.

Lat. 38° 40' Long 61° 30'

Tuesday, Mar. 16th First part, hazy weather
and moderate winds from the S.E.
steering by the wind to the south.
Middle part, strong wind from the
S.E. tacked Ship to the N.E. Latter
part some rain. tacked Ship to the S.E.

Lat. 39° 20' Long 52° 20'

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Wednesday, Mar. 17th fine weather and strong
wind from the E. S. E. steering by the wind
to the S.E. lowered one boat for Black-
fish, variously employed. Middle part
strong winds and rainy. Latter part, fine
weather and strong winds at N. North. steering
E. S. E. variously employed.

Lat. 39° 15' Long 53° 10'

Thursday, Mar. 18th First part, squally with
strong winds from the North steering
E. S. E. variously employed, picked up a log
of wood. Middle part, fine weather. Latter
part, the same, variously employed.

Lat. 39° 20' Long 58° 20'

Friday, Mar. 19th First part fine weather
and strong wind from the N.E. steering
E. S. E. variously employed. Middle
part, rainy, we had a heavy squall from
the N.W. took in all sail. Latter part
moderate but rainy.

Lat. 39° 40' Long 61° 9'

Saturday, Mar. 20th First part, rainy
with moderate wind from the N.W. steering
E. S. E. Middle part, rainy,
dirty, frosty weather with strong wind.
Latter part, the same.

Lat. 39° 10' Long 63° 10'

Sunday, Mar. 21st First part, hazy weather
and strong wind from the N.E. steering E. S. E.
Middle part, & Latter part, the same.

Lat. 39° 40' Long 64° 40'

Monday, Mar. 22nd First part, hazy
weather and strong gales from the E. S. E.
steering by the wind to the S.E.
Middle part, strong gales and squally.
Latter part, the same, wind at E. S. E.

Lat. 40° 50' Long 65° 19'
