weather and strong wind, employed
stowing down. Middle part, 0
Latter part, finished stowing down.

Thursday, May 6th. Lat. 22.00' Long 109.
First part, fine
weather and strong winds, variously
employed. Middle part, shortened
sail. Latter part, strong winds steering
at 0, variously employed.

Friday, May 7th. Lat. 21.35' Long 109.30'.
First part, fine weather
and strong winds, steering at 0.
variously employed. Middle part,
strong wind. Latter part, employed
fitting Royal mast.

Lat. 19.21' Long 112.00'

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cruising for Spum Whales off the coast of 116
Saturday, May 8th. First part, fine weather
and strong winds, variously employed.
Middle part, shortened sail. Latter part,
variously employed. Saw porpoises.

Sunday, May 9th. Lat. 18.15' Long 115.18'.
First part, fine
weather and baffling wind. Sent up
our Royal mast & yards. Middle part,
shortened sail. Latter part, saw jammers.

Monday, May 10th. Lat. 18.29' Long 113.40'.
First part, fine weather
and strong wind from the East, steering
by the wind to the Northward. Middle part,
shortened sail. Latter part, cruising for whales.

Tuesday, May 11th. Lat. 15.17' Long 116.20'.
First part, fine weather
and light breezes, steering by the wind to
the N. E. variously employed. Middle part,
rainy weather. Latter part, squally rainy
weather and thunder. Saw porpoises.

Wednesday, May 12th. Lat. 14.60' Long 114.49'.
First part, rainy
weather and strong squall, saw a finback.
Middle part, rainy. Latter part, the
same, with thunder & lightning.

Thursday, May 13th. Lat. 13.55' Long 116.00'.
First part, rainy
weather and moderate wind, from
the N. W. steering East. Latter part,
fine weather, wind at West.

Friday, May 14th. Lat. 12.50' Long 115.29'.
First part, fine weather
and strong wind at West, steering by
the wind, variously employed. Middle
part, calm. Latter part,
saw Humpbacks, variously employed.
