Remarks on Board Ship *Norinian*. White.
Friday May 27th First part. fine weather
and moderate wind at S.E. steering
N.W. by N. kept our chains. Middle
part. lying at anchor. Latter part. a very light
breeze. Steaming N.W. made Clapp Island
bearing N.W. dist 12 miles.

Lat. 7° 9' Long 105° 41'

Saturday May 28th First part. fine weather
and moderate wind at S.E. steering
N.W. by N. made Java Head. bearing N.W.
by N. dist 30 miles. run down within
12, and luffed too. Middle part. lying off
and on. Latter part. a moderate breeze
at N.E. endeavouring to beat into
the Straits.

Sunday May 29th First part. amoderate
breeze at N.E. steering to beat into the
Straits, found it impossible, owing
to a strong lee current, run off to the
Eastward, so as to take the trade
wind when they come. a most awful
disappointment to the Captain. Middle
part. lying off & on. Latter part
light baffling wind, endeavouring
to enter the Straits. saw a sail Java
Head bearing N.W. dist 7 miles.

Monday May 30th First part. fine
weather and light winds from every
point of the compass. did not make
any progress. tried the current
it showed it setting E. by S. 2 knots.
Middle part. heavy rain squalls with
thunder & lightning. Latter part. a light
breeze at N.W. by N. still steering. boarded
a Dutch Barque, the *Valperio* of days
from Rotterdam, bound to Batavia.

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on her passage towards Sijer. June 1st
Tuesday June 1st First part. calm, tried
the current and it setting S.E. by E. 1 1/2 knots.
Middle part. a light breeze from the Eastward.
Latter part. passed first point at 3 A.M.
at 12 o'clock anchored off on in the entrance
of New Bay. in 11 fathoms water.

Wednesday June 2nd First part all hands
as busy as the devil in a gale of wind
getting water casks ready. Latter part
got off 150 Hb water and a boat load of same.

Thursday June 3rd First part. slowing down
water painted the bunks. got off 30 Hb water.
Latter part. employed stowing water and
cutting wood.

Friday June 4th First part. got off 75
Hb water. stowing water and cutting wood.
Latter part. employed wooding & watering.

Saturday June 5th First part. employed
wooding. Latter part the same.

Sunday June 6th First part. employed
wooding & watering. some shooting &
some fishing. Latter part. at 7 o'clock
A.M. got underway and steering up
the Straits of Sunda with a gentle
breeze at S.E.

Monday June 7th First part fine weather
and baffling wind at all points. at sunset
third point bore N.E. by E. dist 9 miles.
Middle part. rainy with thunder &
lightning and baffling winds.
Latter part. fine weather and light
breeze. steering for Angier point.
