Sunday July 13th First part clear weather
and strong gale at South steering to the
East. Middle part, strong gales. Latter
part the same. Saw Kumpback.

Monday July 14th First part, clear weather
and strong gale at S. S. E. steering to the
East. Middle part, wore ship to the S. W.
Latter part, strong gales.

Tuesday July 20th First part, fine weather
and strong gale at S. E. steering to the
S. S. W. Middle part, the same. Latter
part, steering to the E. S. E.

Wednesday 21st First part, fine weather
and strong gale at S. E. steering to the
S. S. W. variously employed. Middle
part, steering to the E. S. E. Latter part
employed striking down our oil.
steering to the E. S. E.

Thursday 22nd First part fine weather
and strong gale at S. E. steering to the
S. S. W. variously employed. Middle
part, the same. Latter part
rather more moderate.

Friday July 23rd First part, fine weather
and strong wind at E. S. E. steering to
the South. Middle part, the same.
Latter part, saw a body of Sperm whales
lowered and struck one killed him
took him alongside and commenced cut

Saturday July 24th First part strong gale
finished cutting Middle part, steering up
Latter part, commenced boiling

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Sunday July 23rd First part
strong gale at S. E. boiling. Middle part, the
same. Latter part, boiling. Saw Kumpback.

Monday July 24th First part fine weather
and moderate wind at S. E. steering
to the E. S. E. at 2 P. M. finished boiling
Middle part, calm. Latter part, calm
employed repairing sails.

Tuesday July 25th First part fine weather
and calm. Saw a school of Sperm whales
lowered our boats in pursuit, but did
not succeed in striking. Middle
part, squally. Latter part, strong wind at
S. S. W. steering to the S. E. and cut the
main top sail and bent another.

Wednesday 26th First part fine weather
and strong wind at South steering
to the E. S. E. employed sail, saw
fimbals. Middle part, strong gale
Latter part, the same. Tying up under
close reefed main top sail.

Thursday 27th First part, clear weather
and strong gale at S. E. tying up under
main top sail, hoisted to the S. S. W.
Middle part, the same. Latter part, more
moderate wind at S. E. steering to the
E. S. E. employed repairing sail.

Friday July 28th First part fine weather
and strong gale at S. E. steering to the E. S. E.
employed repairing sail, unbent the main
top sail and bent another. Middle part,
shortened sail. Latter part, employed
repairing sails.

and strong gale at S. E. steering to the E. S. E.
employed repairing sail, unbent the main
top sail and bent another. Middle part,
shortened sail. Latter part, employed
repairing sails.
