Remarks on Board Ship *Norman* while on her passage.
Saturday Oct. 30th First part fine weather and
light breeze at East, steering to the S. S. E. variously
employed. Middle part, calm. Latter part,
the same, variously employed.

Lat 22° 26' Long 94° 26'
Sunday Oct. 31st First part, fine weather and
calm, unbent our fore topgallant sail and bent
another. Middle part, calm. Latter part, light
breeze at North, steering S. E.

Lat 22° 57' Long 94° 30'
Monday, Nov. 1st First part, fine weather and
calm. Middle part, calm. Latter part the same
employed repairing a topgallant sail.

Lat 23° 18' Long 95° 20'
Tuesday Nov. 2nd First part fine weather and light
breeze at East, steering S. E. unbent the main top
gallant sail, and bent another. Middle part,
nearly calm. Latter part, a light breeze at E. steering
S. E. variously employed. Saw porpoises.

Lat 24° 9' Long 95° 40'
Wednesday, Nov. 3rd First part, fine weather and light
breeze at E. steering S. E. variously employed.
Middle part, the same. Latter part, the same.

Lat 24° 45' Long 95° 9'
Thursday, Nov. 4th First part, fine weather and
light breeze at North, steering S. E. E.
Saw a finback. Middle part, the same. Latter
part, moderate wind at South, steering to the
E. S. E. unbent the mainsail and commenced
repairing it.

Lat 24° 58' Long 95° 57'
Friday, Nov. 5th First part, fine weather &
moderate winds at South, steering to the
E. S. E. finished the mainsail and bent it.
Middle part, strong winds at South. Latter
part the same. Cleaned the water Butts
and filled them with water.

Lat 25° 14' Long 97° 13'

continued toward Whaling ground. Saturday
Nov. 6th First part fine weather and moderate
winds at South, steering E. S. E. variously employed.
Middle part, the same. Latter part, wind S. W.
steering S. E. saw a sail, unbent the fore and bent.

Lat 25° 29' Long 99° 50'.
Sunday Nov. 7th First part fine weather and strong
winds at S. W. steering S. E. variously employed.
Middle part, strong gales. Latter part made moderate
steering E. by S.

Lat 26° 10' Long 102° 15'
Monday, Nov. 8th First part, fine weather
and strong winds at S. S. E. steering East.
Saw a finback. Middle part, moderate winds
at South. Latter part the same, tacked ship to
the S. W. saw a sail, variously employed.

Lat 27° 35' Long 106° 22'.
Tuesday, Nov. 9th First part, fine weather and
moderate winds at S. E. steering to the S. S. W.
sent down our fore and main masts and sent up
signal poles. Middle part, buffing winds.
Latter part, strong winds at S. E. steering to the S.
S. W. employed making scrubbooms.

Lat 27° 17' Long 103° 47'.
Wednesday, Nov. 10th First part, cloudy weather
and light winds at S. E. steering to the S. S. W.
employed making scrubbooms. Middle part,
light buffing winds at N. to S. steering to the
S. E. Latter part the same, employed
cleaning iron work.

Lat 28° 2' Long 106° 10'.
Thursday, Nov. 11th First part, fine weather
and light breeze at West, steering East.
employed cleaning iron work and filling boats
gripes. Middle part, nearly calm. Latter part
a gentle breeze at N. W. steering E. S. E. saw
a finback, and a large piece of squid.
variously employed.
