strong gales at N. W. steering S. S. W. Middle
part, steering S. W. Latter part, the same.
Saw a school of Blackfish, did not lower.

Wednesday, Nov. 17th First part, fine weather &
strong winds at S. W. steering to the S. S. E.
Middle part, the same. Latter part, few porpoises.

Thursday, Nov. 18th First part, fine weather &
calm. Middle part, light rain, at S. W.
steering to the N. W. Latter part, calm.
employed setting, taut, the headrigging.

Friday, Nov. 19th First part, weather fine with
light air at S. W. steering S. W. Middle part,
the same. Latter part, foggy weather and
moderate wind, employed cooping provision.

light air at S. E. steering to the S. S. W.
employed setting taut the foremast rigging
& washing ship. Steer. Middle part, light
breeze at S. S. E. steering S. S. W.
Latter part, the same. Saw a school of
Blackfish lowered and caught on.

Monday, Nov. 22nd First part, fine weather
& strong winds at S. W. steering S.
Middle part, wind hauled to south. Steer
to the East. Latter part, wore ship to the S. W.

Tuesday, Nov. 23rd First part, fine weather and
strong winds at East, steering South, filled up
the water bulk. Middle part, strong wind
at East, steering to the southward, some
rain, employed hauling our Blackfish.

Wednesday, Nov. 24th First part, fine weather
with rain, wind from E. to S. S. E. steering
to the southward & westward, finished hauling
our Blackfish, set up the main top gallant
slooping, Middle part, wind hauled to
the S. W. steering S. E. Latter part, fine weather
and the fore & main top sail & fore & main
sail, and set other, saw a sail and a finback.

Thursday, Nov. 25th First part, fine weather
and moderate wind at S. S. W. steering
E. S. E. a sail, variously employed. Middle
part, the same. Latter part, strong gale
