Saturday, Nov. 27th First part, fine weather and
strong wind at South, steering to the E. S. E.
employed repairing gill. Middle part, light
wind. Latter part, calm. Bent a gill.

Sunday, Nov. 28th First part, fine weather and
calm, variously employed. Saw a Steamship.
Latter part, moderate wind at E. steering
to the South. Saw three sails. Light rain.

Monday, Nov. 29th First part, fine weather
and moderate wind at S. E. steering to
the S. S. W. Saw porpoises. Middle part,
calm. Latter part, moderate wind at North
steering S. E. by E. employed shifting oil
between to taken ship.

Tuesday, Nov. 30th First part, fine weather and
moderate winds at North. Steering S. E. by
E. saw a body of sperm whales going quick
to windward, lowered our boats but could
not come up with them. Middle part
shortened sail. Latter part, steering by the
wind to the S. E. some light rain.

Wednesday, Dec. 1st First part, fine weather
and light wind at N. W. steering S. E. by
E. struck a porpoise, lost him. Middle
part, light wind. Latter part, light baffling wind
from South to N. W. Saw a finback. Some rain.

Thursday, Dec. 2nd First part, fine weather and light
wind from N. W. to E. steering S. E. by E. variously
employed. Middle part,

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passage from the Indian, to the Pacific Ocean.
Thursday, Dec. 2nd Middle part, wind suddenly
hauled to the S. S. W. steering S. E. by E. Latter
part, strong wind at South. Saw finbacks &
a sail.

Friday, Dec. 3rd First part, fine weather and
strong winds at South, steering E. S. E. saw
finbacks, porpoises, and a sail. Middle part,
light breeze. Latter part, the same. filled the
water butts. Saw finbacks.

Saturday, Dec. 4th First part, fine weather
and calm. few finbacks. Middle part,
a light breeze at N. E. which increased
to a strong one. Latter part, strong wind
steering S. E. by E. struck a porpoise.

Sunday, Dec. 5th First part, clear weather
and strong winds at N. E. steering S. E.
by E. Middle part, the same. some rain.
Latter part, rather more moderate, steering S. E.

Monday, Dec. 6th First part, cloudy weather
and strong winds at N. E. steering E. S. E.
Middle part, wind at North, steering East.
Latter part, wind at N. W. saw two sails & finback.

Tuesday, Dec. 7th First part, fine weather and moderate
winds at N. W. steering East. a sail in sight
saw many finbacks. Middle part, wind at
N. W. Latter part, wind at N. W. saw many finbacks.

Wednesday, Dec. 8th First part, fine weather and
a strong breeze at North, steering East. Middle
part, the same. Latter part, baffling wind from
the N. W. to N. with rain.

wind from N. W. to E. steering S. E. by E. variously
employed. Middle part,
