Sunday, Jan 22nd. First part, fine weather
and strong winds at South. Employed boiling
saw a flock of wild ducks. Middle part.
Latter part. Saw porpoise.

Lat 34° 29' Long 158° 19'
Monday, Jan 23rd. First part, fine
weather and strong winds at S. S. 90
Steering S. E. Saw a schooner. Middle
part. Struck a porpoise. Latter part. put out the
main top gallant sail. Saw a beach.

Lat 35° 12' Long 158° 20'
Tuesday, Jan 24th. First part, equally with strong
gales at S. W. Steering East. Ripped up an old
top gallant sail. Latter part. saw porpoises. considered
bent a main top gallant sail.

Lat 35° 12' Long 170° 30'
Wednesday, Jan 25th. First part, fine weather and
moderate winds at S. W. Steering S. E. variously
employed. Middle part. luffed to the wind.
Latter part. Steering E. by N. exchanged signals
with an English Barge the James Ross.
from Sydney bound to London. Struck a porpoise

Lat 35° 13' Long 171° 41'
Thursday, Jan 27th. First part, fine weather
and moderate winds at S. W. Steering to the
E. by N. made the Three Kings bearing E. by E.
dist 50 miles. Spoke Barge Woodlark 9 months
out from Sydney 250 sp. Latter part. saw B. &
saw a school of sperm whale a very long distance
off lowered our boat in pursuit.

Lat 35° 20' Long 176° 34'
Friday, Jan 28th. First part, fine weather in
pursuit of whale struck and killed him
took him along side cut his body in.
Latter part. cut in the head and commenced
boiling. Saw Woodlark. caught a porpoise

Lat 35° 30' Long 180° 40'
Saturday, Jan 29th. First part, fine weather
and moderate winds at S. E. saw 3 vessels
boiled middle part. employed boiling

Sunday Jan 30th. First part, fine weather and
moderate wind at South. employed boiling
Middle part, finished boiling. Latter part.
Steering E. by N. saw porpoise

Lat 34° 14' Long 159° 49'
Monday, Jan 31st. First part, fine weather
and light breeze at West. Steering East.
saw a sail. B. fish, porpoise, & 3 Sam-pura's.
Middle part. Steering West. Latter part. saw the
King's Spoke. Barge loaded of B. fish. saw several
vessels.

Lat 34° 12' Long 170° 20'
Tuesday, Jan 32nd. First part, fine weather
and strong winds at West. Spoke ship Planter
of Benluebet 9 months out 120 wh. 60 sp.
Middle part. Steering by the wind. Latter
part. wind S. W. Steering S. by W. saw two sails

Lat 34° 19' Long 170° 39'
Wednesday, Feb 3rd. First part, fine weather
and strong gales, steering by the wind, in company
with Planter. saw Woodlark. Middle part.
shortened sail. Latter part. light winds, put
out in the lubber room. saw two sails.

Lat 34° 00' Long 175° 20'
Thursday, Feb 5th. First part, fine weather &
light winds at West, cruising. the King in
sight. saw porpoise, & a sail, the Planter.
hy bent the fore top sail and bent another.
Middle part. a mail from Capt. Pease.
Latter part. repairing fore top sail.

Lat 31° 11' Long 174° 10'
Friday, Feb 6th. First part, cloudy weather &
strong winds at N. E. Steering on different
tack repairing fore top sail. Middle part.
some rain. Latter part. in company with
Planter.

Lat 34° 50' Long 175° 10'
Saturday, Feb 7th. First part, fine weather and
moderate wind in company with Planter
