

Tuesday, Apr 12th First part, strong wind at E.S.E. lying close in under the island taking on board, potatoes, game fruit, some fowl, some turkey and a pig. Middle part, rained all night and blew like hair & feathers from the S.E. Latter part, same, toward 12 o'clock it cleared off and the land became once more visible, steering for it.

Wednesday, Apr 13th First part strong wind at S.E. and lying under the lee of the island finishing our business at 3 P.M. left off W.M. employed stowing away our security. Middle part, steering W.M. until 12 o'clock, and luffed to the wind headed to the S.E. at 2 o'clock. Stead W.M. S.E. weather very thick and raining. Latter part, strong gales and raining at 7 P.M. luffed too, at 11 P.M. saw Borolonga, bearing S.W. 23 miles, steering for it.

Thursday, Apr 14th First part, cloudy weather and moderate wind at E.S.E. at 10 A.M. received visit from the shore, we hear from the natives that the Hope was here yesterday, and that Capt. Good is on shore. Chase went ashore in a boat that came off to us. Middle part, all kinds of weather and wind. Latter part, stood in shore and sent in a raft of bark, &c, and took a boat load of wood.

Friday, Apr 15th First part, wind S.E. and rainy, took on board our raft, and put some below, the weather looks very bad, Middle part, rainy squally. Latter part, same, employed stowing water.

Saturday, Apr 16th First part, squally, rainy with strong gales from N.E. to S.E. employed stowing, sent in a raft of 15 casks for water. Spoke Hope of New Bedford, Mr. Cleveland payed a visit.

Sunday, Apr 17th First part, Middle part, squally, wind from all quarters. Latter part, took on board our raft of water.

Monday, Apr 18th First part, quite a nice day for the country, took off two boat loads of wood and one half of a Bullhook. Middle part, calm & rainy. Latter part, light variable wind with rain.

Tuesday, Apr 19th First part, variable wind with rain. Middle part, same. Latter part, the wind light at N.W. and cloudy with light rain.

Wednesday, Apr 20th First part, cloudy weather and light wind at N.W. Middle part, same. Latter part, rainy, with thunder & lightning.

Thursday, Apr 21st First part, cloudy weather and moderate wind at N.W. we can do nothing, as the wind blows on shore. Middle part, fine weather. Latter part, fine weather with light wind at N.W. working up to the landing, was boarded by some of the natives.

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Friday, Apr 22nd First part, squally, with variable winds, got a boat load of wood from Mr. Feltman and a quantity of fruit. Latter part, fine weather and light wind at N.W. got off a boat load of wood.

Saturday, Apr 23rd First part, some squalls, got off a boat load of wood. Middle part, fine weather. Latter part, one third of our crew on liberty.

Sunday, Apr 24th First part, squally weather and moderate wind at E.S.E. Middle & Latter part, same, two of our men desecrated.

Monday, Apr 25th First part, strong gales at E.S.E. under three close reefed topsails. Middle & Latter part, same.
