Wednesday, May 21st First part, fine weather and light wind at South. So West, at 5 P.M. wind at N.W. Tacked Ship to the S.W. variously employed. Middle part, same. Latter part, moderate wind at N.W. variously employed.

Lat 27° 4' Long 174° 9'

Thursday, May 22nd First part, fine weather and moderate wind at N.W. Steering to the S.W. variously employed. Latter part, employed cooping our bread.

Lat 26° 49' Long 172° 45'

Friday, May 23rd First part, fine weather and moderate wind at N.W. Steering by the wind to the N.W. variously employed. Saw porpoises. Middle part, tacked Ship to the North. Latter part, employed clearing iron work.

Lat 25° 10' Long 172° 30'

Saturday, May 24th First part, fine weather and light air at N.W. Steering by the wind to the North, saw porpoises. Middle part, variable wind, with light rain squalls. Latter part, same, steering to the westward.

Lat 23° 9' Long 171° 45'

Sunday, May 25th First part, fine weather and moderate wind at N.W. Steering to the N.W. variously employed. Middle part, shortened sail, and altered the Watch. Latter part, saw fin back steering N.W. by N.

Lat 21° 9' Long 171° 57'

Monday, May 26th First part, cloudy weather and moderate wind at N.W. Steering N.W. by W. Saw fin back, saw a log of wood. Middle part, shortened sail. Latter part, Steeking West, saw several fin back, caught two porpoises.

Lat 20° 39' Long 169° 40'

Tuesday, May 27th First part, hazy weather and light winds at S.E. Steering West, variously employed. Middle part, shortened sail. Latter part, calm, lowered for Blackfish. Struck three, and saved one, caught a turtle.

Lat 20° 15' Long 168° 30'

Wednesday, June 1st First part, fine weather and light air at S.W. off closing Blackfish, has caught two sharks, one a short finned. Middle part, shortened sail. Latter part, calm. Saw porpoises.

Lat 20° 13' Long 167° 40'

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from Coralonga towards Japan. Thursday, June 2nd First part, fine weather and light air at N.W. Saw porpoises, fin back, variously employed. Middle part, shortened sail. Latter part, tacked our Blackfish, saw fin back & porpoise.

Lat 30° 20' Long 177° 35'

Friday, June 3rd First part, fine weather and light wind at N.W. Steering to the N.W. saw porpoises and fin back, variously employed. Middle part, shortened sail. Latter part, moderate wind at N.W. Steering to the N.W. Saw porpoises.

Lat 31° 17' Long 177° 49'

Saturday, June 4th First part, fine weather and gentle winds at N.W. Steering to the N.W. Saw porpoises & fin back. Middle part, shortened sail. Latter part, saw fin back & porpoise. Blackfish, caught one Blackfish.

Lat 31° 14' Long 178° 35'

Sunday, June 5th First part, fine weather and light air at N.W. Steering by the wind to the South, saw fin back porpoises, & Blackfish, a large tree and a turtle. Middle part, shortened sail, calm & foggy. Latter part, a rain and breeze at South, steering North. Saw fin back & grampsea porpoises, caught a turtle.

Lat 30° 37' Long 180° 45'

Monday, June 6th First part, fine weather and light air at South, steering North. Saw porpoises grampsea & fin back and sail. Middle part, spoke Ship. Hope of a few Porpoises was had taken nothing since leaving Coralonga. Latter part, a fine breeze at South, steering N.W. Saw fin back & porpoise. Hope in sight.

Lat 31° 00' Long 180° 50'

Tuesday, June 7th First part, fine weather and moderate breeze at South, steering N.W. saw fin back & porpoises. Hope in sight. Middle part, shortened sail. Latter part, strong gale, variously employed.

Lat 32° 00' Long 184° 30'

Wednesday, June 8th First part, strong gale at S.W. Steering to the West, wind hauled to the West, wore ships to the South. saw a log of wood. Middle part, fine weather. Latter part, strong winds at N.W. & N. Steering to the S.W. variously employed.
