

Sunday, June 19th First part, rainy weather and strong winds at S.W. employed clearing away Middle part, raining at 3 P.M. commenced boiling at 5 M. cooled down on account of rain. Latter part, strong gale at North, with much rain.

Monday, June 20th First part strong gale at North with rain, at 3 P.M. commenced boiling Middle part, boiling, Latter part, same.

Tuesday, June 21st First part, fine weather and moderate winds at North steering to the East, at 4 P.M. finished boiling, Middle part shortened sail, Latter part, employed setting up shooks. Steering S.W. Wind E.S.E.

Wednesday, June 22nd First part, fine weather and light wind at E.S.E. steering North, employed setting up shooks, Middle part shortened sail, Latter part, variously employed, saw finbacks, steering to the N.E.

Thursday, June 23rd First part fine weather and light E.S.E. wind steering to the N.E. variously employed, Middle part, ship headed to the Westward, Latter part, caught 150 albacore.

Friday, June 24th First part, wind light at S.S.W. steering to the Westward, saw many finbacks, variously employed, Middle part, shortened sail, Latter part, ship headed to the S.E. saw finbacks, variously employed.

Saturday, June 25th First part, fair weather and light breeze at S.S.W. ship headed to the S.E. lowered our boats for Blackfish without success, variously employed, Middle part, shortened sail, Latter part, saw finback.

Sunday, June 26th First part, fine weather and light breeze at South, ship headed to the E.S.E. middle part foggy, Latter part same, saw finback.
