Remarks on Board Ship *Norman* while cruising
Sunday Aug 15th First part, fine weather and light wind at S. S. W. Steering to the

Eastward, saw pumpkins, Grampuses, & Porpoises, employed catching Whales
and various other fish. Middle part, calm. Latter part, a moderate breeze
at S. S. W. steering E. by S. saw pumpkins.

Lat 33° 40' Long 175° 00'

Monday Aug 16th First part, fine weather and moderate winds at S. S. W. Steering
E. by S. saw pumpkins. Latter part, steering to the E. S. E. saw pumpkins
variously employed, caught some Whales.

Lat 33° 26' Long 177° 11' East

Tuesday Aug 17th First part, cloudy weather and light wind at South, steering to the E. S. E.
Lat 32° 20' took ship to the N. W. saw pumpkins, Porpoises, variously employed,
a light fall of rain. Latter part, wind S. S. E. steering East, saw pumpkins
& Finbacks employed drawing & blotting yarn, and clearing the potatoe house.

Lat 33° 7' Long 177° 30' East

Wednesday Aug 18th First part, fine weather and moderate winds at S. S. E. Steering
East, employed caulking around the stanchion on the Starboard water
saw pumpkins. Latter part, steering to the S. W. employed caulking the
waterway across the Starboard side of the water tank. saw pumpkins.

Lat 33° 5' Long 177° 15'

Thursday Aug 19th First part, fine weather and moderate winds at E. S. E.
Steering to the S. E. saw pumpkins, & Porpoises, variously employed,
Latter part, steering to the S. S. E. employed overhauling, ballast
blocks, and various small jobs in the carpentering, hove over
the Starboard water, saw Grampuses.

Lat 32° 46' Long 177° 29'

Friday Aug 20th First part, fine weather and light wind at East, steering to
the S. S. E. saw Grampuses, & Porpoises, variously employed, Latter
part employed cleaning iron work, saw Grampuses.

Lat 32° 16' Long 177° 20'

Saturday Aug 21st First part, fine weather and light wind at E. S. E. Steering
to the S. E. saw a school of Spinn Whales going S. W. toward our boat
and struck one, killed him, took him alongside, Middle part,
preparat to cut. Latter part cut him in and cleared away
saw Finbacks, Grampuses, & Porpoises.

Lat 32° 00' Long 177° 00'

Sunday Aug 22nd First part, calm, at 12 M. commenced boiling
saw Grampuses, & Porpoises, Middle part employed boiling
Latter part, at ten M. finished boiling, saw a school of
Spinn Whales to windward, endeavouring to beat the ship up to the

Lat 32° 40' Long 175° 4'

for Spinn Whales on paper.

Monday Aug 22nd First part squally, at 2 P.M. toward our boat in pursuit of whale
struck one, and lost him by his taking two lines, took up the boat.
Latter part, squally with baffling wind and calm all hand looking for
the whale, without success, saw Grampuses, some rain.

Tuesday Aug 23rd First part, fine weather and light wind at S. W. Steering various
courses, variously employed, saw Blackfish, and pumpkins. Latter part, saw pump-
kins employed running and coiling new lines, steering to the S. E.

T. C. A. M. Lat 31° 51' Long 177° 40'

Wednesday Aug 24th First part, fine weather and moderate winds at S. W. Steering
to the S. E. toward the S. E. struck the oil of the last whale down in the
kitchen, saw pumpkins. Latter part employed repairing the mast
boat, saw Grampuses, T. C. A. M.

Lat 31° 30' Long 177° 00' E

Thursday Aug 25th First part, fine weather and light wind at N. E. W. Steering
to the S. W. employed repairing the Mast boat, saw Grampuses, Latter part,
wind S. E. Steering S. E. variously employed, saw Finbacks, Porpoises, & Grampuses.

T. C. A. M. Lat 31° 24' Long 177° 50' E

Friday Aug 26th First part, fine weather and light wind at S. E. Steering various
courses, variously employed, saw Finbacks, pumpkins, Grampuses, & Porpoises,
a great many Whales around the ship, Latter part, strong wind at S. E.
Steering to the S. W. saw a great many pumpkins, variously employed,

Lat 30° 29' Long 177° 1'

Saturday Aug 27th First part, fine weather and moderate winds at S. E. Steering to the
S. W. saw many pumpkins, variously employed, Latter part, steering E. S. E.
employed breaking out for provisions.

Lat 31° 14' Long 177° 24'

Sunday Aug 28th First part, fine weather and light wind at S. E. Steering to the
S. W. employed breaking out for provisions, Latter part, wind at East
steering North, saw pumpkins.

Lat 31° 50' Long 177° 10'

Monday Aug 29th First part, fine weather and moderate winds at East, steering to the
S. W. saw pumpkins. Latter part, steering to the S. S. E. saw pumpkins, variously
employed.

Lat 32° 6' Long 177° 50'

Tuesday Aug 30th First part, fine weather and moderate winds at East.
Steering to the S. S. E. saw Finbacks & pumpkins. Latter part
steering to the S. E. saw pumpkins & Finbacks, variously employed
had one or two slight rain squalls, caught a shark.

Lat 32° 41' Long 177° 30'
