Wednesday, Aug. 31st First part, fine weather and moderate wind at E. S. E.
Many to the E. S. E. variously employed saw pumpkins, caught

Thursday, Sept. 1st First part, fine weather and squally weather, wind at East, steering
to the S. S. E. latter part, calm, variously employed.

Friday, Sept. 2nd First part, fine weather and light breeze at East, steering to the
E. S. E. variously employed, caught three dolphins, latter part, rising
weather and backing winds, saw pumpkins.

Lat. 32° 40' Long. 177° 55' East.

Saturday, Sept. 3rd First part, fine weather and backing winds, steering to the
East, caught two dolphins, some down, latter part, fine weather and strong
wind at East, steering to the E. S. E. saw pumpkins, variously employed.

Lat. 32° 34' Long. 178° 27'

Sunday, Sept. 4th First part, fine weather and moderate winds at East, steering
to the E. S. E. saw pumpkins, variously employed, latter part, steering to the
S. S. E. saw pumpkins & Porpoises.

Lat. 32° 37' Long. 180° 05'

Monday, Sept. 5th First part, fine weather and moderate wind at East, steering to
the S. S. E. saw pumpkins, latter part, steering to the E. S. E. saw pumpkins
employed overhauling sails.

Lat. 31° 7' Long. 180° 52'

Tuesday, Sept. 6th First part, fine weather and moderate winds at East
steering to the E. S. E. employed repairing sails that have been
slightly damaged by rain, saw pumpkins, latter part, wind S. E.
steering to E. S. E. saw pumpkins started water.

Lat. 30° 53' Long. 181° 51' E.

Wednesday, Sept. 7th First part, fine weather and moderate wind at E. S. E. steering to
the E. S. E. saw pumpkins, variously employed, latter part, calm.

Lat. 30° 55' Long. 175° 57' W.

Thursday, Sept. 8th First part, fine weather and light winds at E. S. E. steering to
the East, saw pumpkins & Finbacks, latter part, coopered some of
the oil we have in the blubber rooms, saw pumpkins.

Friday, Sept. 9th First part, fine weather and moderate wind at E. S. E.
steering to the East, saw pumpkins & Porpoises, variously employed,
latter part, strong wind at S. W. steering East, saw a great many pumpkins.

Lat. 28° 6' Long. 175° 26' W.

Monday, Sept. 10th First part, fine weather and strong wind at S. W. steering East, saw
many pumpkins, latter part, saw pumpkins, upset the surgeon's top sail and
commenced repairing it, found our carpenter's work here we

at last found that we thought we ought to have had, but had not
steered away in a pocket of a locker, that we did not know was
a locker, but discovered it by accident, or likewise found several other
articles that we knew nothing about, a canister of powder, another
of varnish, a few planes, an auger, a bag of nails.

Tuesday, Sept. 11th First part, fine weather and moderate wind at S. W. steering
East, at work on the surgeon's top sail, saw pumpkins, this day, we altered calling it
Saturday, latter part, at work on the surgeon's part, saw pumpkins,
light winds at E. S. E. steering East.

Lat. 32° 37' Long. 180° 40' W.

Wednesday, Sept. 12th First part, fine weather and light winds at E. S. E. steering East,
but the surgeon's top sail, saw pumpkins, latter part, calm, saw Porpoises.

Lat. 32° 14' Long. 180° 1' W.

Thursday, Sept. 13th First part, fine weather and light wind at E. S. E. steering to the East,
saw Porpoises, latter part, wind at E. S. E. steering East, employed washing under
the "Korea".

Lat. 32° 17' Long. 180° 50' W.

Friday, Sept. 14th First part, fine weather and moderate wind at E. S. E.
steering to the S. E. variously employed, at 5 o'clock, lashed ship to the chills,
latter part, steering to the Southward, saw pumpkins, variously employed.

Lat. 30° 55' Long. 180° 40' W.

Saturday, Sept. 15th First part, fine weather and strong wind at E. S. E. steering to the
North, saw pumpkins, latter part, wind East, steering to the E. S. E. S. E.

Lat. 32° 25' Long. 180° 0'

Sunday, Sept. 16th First part, fine weather and strong wind at E. S. E. steering
to the E. S. E. variously employed, latter part, the same.

Lat. 30° 55' Long. 180° 28' W.

Monday, Sept. 17th First part, fine weather and moderate wind at E. S. E.
steering to the S. E. lashed ship to the South, variously employed,
latter part, calm, employed changing and whitewashing the masts.

Lat. 30° 15' Long. 180° 15' W.

Tuesday, Sept. 18th First part, fine weather & calm, variously employed, saw a
Finback, latter part, light air at E. S. E. steering East, employed overhauling
the surgeon's top sail, lashed water.
