Remarks on Board Ship Normans while cruising for

Friday, Nov 17th First part, fine weather and strong wind at East, steering to the S. S. finished the main hold and bent it, otherwise variously employed, latter part, saw a school of Blackfish, started water, sent up the midney, at sunset, otherwise variously employed, wind S.E.

Lat 36° 15' S. Long 152° 45' W.

Saturday, Nov 18th First part, fine weather and moderate wind at S.E., steering to the S. P. W. latched ship to the S.E. variously employed, middle part, latched ship to the south, latter part, employed repairing the mizen stopgallant sail, saw Chopies.

Lat 37° S. Long 151° 19' W.

Sunday, Nov 19th First part, fine weather and strong wind at S.E., steering by the wind, to the S.E. variously employed, caught a Yellow Tail, latter part, steering by the wind to the south.

Lat 38° S. Long 151° 25' W.

Monday, Nov 20th First part, fine weather and moderate wind at S.E., steering to the south, latter part, altered the watches, latched watch last 2. W. on deck, latter part, commenced cooping one oil in main hold.

Lat 38° S. Long 152° 50'

Tuesday, Nov 21st First part, fine weather and moderate breeze at S.E. steering by the wind to the south, employed cooping out oil in the main hold, latter part, finished stowing the oil, found one barrel leakage, in two hundred.

Lat 41° S. Long 152° 25' W.

Wednesday, Nov 22nd First part, squally weather and moderate wind at East, employed stowing off the main hold, saw a school of sperm whales, lowered our boat, and struck one, but unfortunately the fast boat was stove and we lost the whale, and line, middle part, latched ship to the S.E. latter part, steering to the south, employed repairing the stove boat.

Lat 41° 15' S. Long 152° 39'

Thursday, Nov 23rd First part, fine weather and moderate wind at East, steering to the south, finished repairing the boat, middle part, steering to the S.E. latter part, steering to the south variously employed.

Friday, Nov 24th First part, fine weather and moderate wind at East, steering to the S.E. variously employed, middle part, the same, latter part, steering to the south variously employed.

Lat 42° 15' S. Long 153° 5' W.

Saturday, Nov 25th First part, fine weather and moderate wind at East, steering to the S.E. variously employed, latter part, saw Fishbacks, employed painting the Boat, latter part, saw Fishbacks, employed painting the Boat.

Lat 50° S. Long 152° 34' W.

Sunday, Nov 26th First part, fine weather and strong wind at East, South, East steering to the S.E. variously employed, saw Chopies, middle part, the same, latter part, steering to the south, saw 2 Diamond fish.

Lat 50° S. Long 152° 34' W.

Monday, Nov 27th First part, fine weather and moderate wind at S.E., steering to the south, saw Chopies, middle part, calm, latter part, calm, variously employed.

Lat 4° S. Lat. 135° 25' W.

Tuesday, Nov 28th First part, fine weather and calm, variously employed, latter part, light breeze at East, steering S.W. saw Killers, variously employed.

Lat 30° S. Long 151° 12'

Wednesday, Nov 29th First part, fine weather and light wind at East, steering S.W. variously employed, middle part, by the wind, latter part, variously employed, saw Chopies, etc. Chopie with comp.

Lat 44° 15' S. Long 154° 50'

Thursday, Nov 30th First part, fine weather and moderate wind at East, steering S.W. employed turning up the Starboard main rigging, latter part, employed setting, turning up the main rigging, saw a school of sperm whales going to windward quick lowered our boat but could not come up with them.

Lat 5° S. Long 153° 16' W.

Friday, Dec 1st First part, fine weather and moderate wind at East, steering to the south, employed turning up the lower rigging, latter part, finished turning up the rigging.

Lat 81° 41' S. Long 153° 15' W.

Saturday, Dec 2nd First part, fine weather and strong breeze at East, steering variously employed, latter part, the head of rigging saw Fishbacks, etc. Blackfish.
