Monday Dec 5th First part, fine weather and moderate wind at
East, steering S.W. by E, latter part, steering S.W. by S
employed setting bait the mizen rigging.

Tuesday Dec 6th First part, fine weather and moderate breeze
at East, steering S.W. by E, employed setting bait the
mizen rigging, latter part, took in the larboard boat
and repaired her, saw Porpoises, steering S. S.W.

Wednesday Dec 7th First part, fine weather and moderate breeze
at E, steering S. S.W. towed our boat for Blackfish but
caught none, painted the larboard boat, otherwise
variously employed, middle part, lying too, latter part
steering S.W. W. variously employed.

Thursday Dec 8th First part, fine weather and moderate wind
at E. S. E. steering S.W. W. variously employed,
latter part, painted waist boat, steering S. by W.

Friday Dec 9th First part, fine weather and moderate wind
at E. S. E. steering S. by W, employed drawing & knotting
Trawl, saw porpoises, latter part, put out the larboard
Boat, variously employed, steering S.W. by N.

Saturday Dec 10th First part, fine weather and moderate wind
at E. S. E. steering S.W. by N, employed drawing & knotting
Trawl, latter part, steering S.W. employed making

Monday Dec 12th First part, fine weather and moderate
wind at E. S. E. steering S. S.W. caught a Blackfish and
a Porpoise, latter part, employed killing one Blackfish
saw two sails, steering W. N. W.

Tuesday Dec 13th First part, fine weather and moderate wind
at East, steering various courses, at 3 P.M. saw Jarvis
Island, bearing N. by E, dist 12 miles, spoke Ship's Office
Wendell & Rice Thence off New Bedford, the Capt went
on board, latter part, steering on different tacks, Jarvis Island
in sight, and the two ships.

Wednesday Dec 14th First part, fine weather and moderate wind
at East, steering on different tacks, boarded the ship
Thazine, latter part, steering different courses, passed
near Jarvis Island, saw three sails.

Thursday Dec 15th First part, fine weather and strong wind
at East, passed near Jarvis Island, steering to the West
latter part, steering to the S. S. E. passed near Jarvis Island
at 9, with tacked ship and stood North.

Friday Dec 16th First part, fine weather and strong gale at East
steering North, saw porpoises, latter part, same.

Saturday Dec 17th First part, fine weather, and strong wind
at E. S. E. with a very rough sea, steering by the wind
to South, variously employed, latter part, the same
started water.

Sunday Dec 18th First part, fine weather and strong wind
at E. S. E. steering by the wind to the South, saw
Jarvis Island off the lee beam, dist 10 miles,
latter part, steering South.
