Latter part, light breeze at East, steering W. S. P. C.

Monday Jan 6th First part, fine weather and moderate
wind at East, steering W. S. P. C. Latter part, the
same, started water, cleaned Kitchens.

Tuesday Jan 7th First part, fine weather and light air
at East, steering W. S. P. C. Latter part, same, worked the foretop sail and
commenced repairing, etc.

Wednesday Jan 8th First part, fine weather and moderate
breeze at East, steering W. S. P. C. finished repairing
foretop sail and bent it, saw Gumpud.
Latter part, tried the Head Stays.

Thursday Jan 9th First part, fine weather and light air
at East, steering W. S. P. C. saw a Finback, employed
making Smit, Latter part, same.

Friday Jan 10th First part, fine weather and light air at East, steering
at S. P. C. put some Clops over the masts, to stand in
Lat 20° N. Long 158° 32'

ing for Norman Whales near the Line, 1854.
Saturday Jan 11th First part, fine weather and light air
steering at S. P. C. Latter part, light wind at North, steering
by the wind to the West, had a slight squall of rain
Lat 21° N. Long 158° 50' W.

Sunday Jan 12th First part, fine weather and baffling wind
from West to North, steering by the wind on both sides
saw Gumpud, some rain, Latter part, variable wind
with much rain, Ship headed from W. to East.

Monday Jan 13th First part, fine weather and baffling wind, Ship
headed from North to East, saw the island of New
Holland, bearing Northward 12 miles, sighted rain
all day, Latter part, moderate wind at W. steering
to the W. S. P. C. by the wind, saw Kitten.

Tuesday Jan 14th First part, fine weather and light air, at S. P. C.
Ship headed to the W. S. P. C. caught three Dolphins and some
other; saw Gumpud, Latter part, fine weather and light
variable wind, steering to the W. S. P. C. by the wind, saw Porpoise.

Wednesday Jan 15th First part, light variable wind and very fair
weather, steering to the Westward, by the wind, saw Porpoise.
Latter part, strong wind at S. P. C. steering at S. P. C.

Thursday Jan 16th First part, strong wind at S. P. C. and fair weather
steering at S. P. C. until 1 P. M. when Ship and Steers South
Latter part, steering S. P. C. employed making Smit.

Friday Jan 17th First part, fair weather and moderate wind at
S. P. C. steering S. P. C. employed making Smit, Latter
part, steering W. S. P. C. employed repairing Smit.

Saturday Jan 18th First part, fine weather and light air at S. P. C.
steering S. P. C. Latter part, steering W. S. P. C. saw Finback.
Started water, wind North, light, some rain.

Sunday Jan 19th First part, fine weather and light breeze at
S. P. C. steering S. P. C. employed cleaning Smit, Latter part
steering West.
