

Remarks Board Ship's No man while cruising,
Saturday April 1st First part, fine weather and light air at 11 A.M. steering to the N. E. employed setting up Shocks in the fore part, and getting up Shocks. weather fine, wind & both light, bearing West
 Lat 21° S Long 171° 40' E.

Sunday April 2nd First part, fine weather and light wind at 11, at 12 steering N. W. saw Bird's nest, variously employed, Latter part, fine weather and light wind at East, steering N. E. S.
 Lat 21° S Long 176° 00' E.

Monday April 3rd First part, fine weather and light air at East steering to the N. E. S. saw Bird's nest, Latter part, equally with much rain, wind East, steering N. E. S.
 Lat 21° S Long 174° 00' E.

Tuesday April 4th First part, squally weather and light wind at East steering N. E. S. saw Bird's nest, Latter part, fine weather and light air at N. E. steering N. W. toward Wood's & Henderson's islands which are in light air 5 leagues.
 Lat 21° S Long 175° 54' E.

Wednesday April 5th First part, fine weather and light air at N. E. being off Henderson's island, some of the natives on board, brought a quantity of cocoa nut, some mats & shells, and one dog, fowl. Latter part, about the 12 o'clock, topsail repaired, it and bent it again, about the 1 o'clock, and dipped it to pieces.
 Lat 20° S Long 174° 00' E.

Thursday April 6th First part, fine weather and moderate wind at N. E. steering N. E. W. bent a new spanker, Latter part employed repairing fore topsail.
 Lat 20° S Long 170° 00' E.

Friday April 7th First part, fine weather and light air at East steering West, employed repairing fore topsail, Latter part saw Ocean island bearing West 12 or 13 miles.
 Lat 20° S Long 169° 50' E.

Saturday April 8th First part, fine weather and light air at N. E. steering N. E. W. was boarded by some of the natives of Ocean island, of whom we purchased some fowl, periwinkle & cocoa nuts, Latter part, equally with much rain, lying near Ocean island, leading with the main.
 Lat 20° S Long 169° 00' E.

Sunday April 9th First part, fine weather and light air at West steering by the wind to the N. E. W. started water, Ocean island Long 169° 00' E. just back from the dock at sundown, Latter part wind at N. E.

Remarks Made among the Group. 1785
Monday April 10th First part, fine weather and light air at N. E. steering to the N. E. Latter part, wind light at S. E. steering N. E. W. about the fore sail repaired, it and bent it again.
 Lat 20° S Long 169° 00' E.

Tuesday April 11th First part, fine weather and very light air at S. E. steering N. E. W. variously employed, lowered for Black's fish without success, Latter part, fine weather and East steering N. W. employed altering the spanker, saw Periwinkle.
 Lat 20° S Long 169° 00' E.

Wednesday April 12th First part, fine weather and moderate wind at East steering N. W. variously employed, Latter part, equally with moderate wind steering N. W. by the employed running up the larboard in a topmast backstay.
 Lat 20° S Long 165° 00' E.

Thursday April 13th First part, equally with much rain, steering N. W. by N. saw Black's fish, Latter part, light wind at N. E. steering N. E. W. employed running up the larboard fore top mast stay.
 Lat 20° S Long 164° 00' E.

Friday April 14th First part, equally with light variable wind at N. E. employed running up the starboard fore top mast stay, Middle part, at 11 A.M. made Strong's island bearing N. by N. dist 20 miles, Latter part, equally with variable weather and variable wind. Ship bore too, about 10 miles, just from Strong's island.

Saturday April 15th First part, equally with variable wind lying to on opposite tack about ten miles west from Strong's island. Latter part, moderate wind at N. E. W. lying off 5 or 6 miles at the windward part of Strong's island, at 12 o'clock off for the leeward part, at 2 P.M. sailed from this ship, took of 1 boat with 10 men, at 3 P.M. kept the ship off N. W. there is nothing to be obtained, here but a few Sarsaparilla & cocoa nuts & wood & water. Latter part, variable & variable wind, course N. W.
 Lat 20° S Long 162° 00' E.

Sunday April 16th First part, fine weather and moderate wind at N. E. W. steering N. E. W. took in sight. Strong's island, Latter part, with N. E. moderate, steering N. E. W. turned up the starboard main top mast backstay.
 Lat 20° S Long 161° 00' E.
