

Remarks on Board Ship Norman while cruising

Thursday May 11th First part, hazy weather and calm, variously employed, latter part, light breeze at East, steering North, under the fore & main topsail and fore & main masts; saw Porpoises;

Lat 20° 00' N. Long 151° 10' E

Friday May 12th First part, fine weather and very light air at East, steering North, under the fore & main topsails, saw Grampuses, latter part, wind at S. E. saw several Finbacks, employed repairing the main sail

Lat 20° 27' N. Long 151° 31' E

Saturday May 13th First part, fine weather and light wind at S. E. steering North, finished repairing the main sail and bent it, saw several Finbacks, latter part, variously employed;

Lat 20° 15' N. Long 151° 15' E

Sunday May 14th First part, fine weather and light wind at S. E. steering N. E. & variously employed, latter part, steering N. E.

Lat 20° 21' N. Long 150° 41' E

Monday May 15th First part, fine weather and moderate breeze at S. E. steering N. E. saw Finbacks, middle part, foggy, latter part, saw a slight squall of rain, saw Grampuses, employed making scrubbooms

Lat 20° 7' N. Long 150° 15' E

Tuesday May 16th First part, fine weather and moderate wind at S. E. steering N. E. employed making scrubbooms, latter part, same.

Lat 20° 49' N. Long 150° 49' E

Wednesday May 17th First part, fair weather, wind S. E. light, steering S. E. variously employed, made a boat sail for the starboard mast, latter part, steering S. E.

Lat 21° 9' N. Long 150° 30' E

Thursday May 18th First part, fair weather and light wind at S. E. steering S. E. & variously employed, latter part, same, employed cleaning iron work.

Lat 21° 20' N. Long 150° 49' E

Friday May 19th First part, fine weather and light breeze at South, steering East, variously employed, found the oakum rotten in some of the seams under each grate, and the keelson forward, caulked them, middle part, calm, latter part, light wind, at South, steering East, saw Grampuses

Lat 21° 45' N. Long 150° 59' E

Saturday May 20th First part, fine weather and moderate wind at South, steering East, variously employed, latter part, same, saw Grampuses

Lat 22° 49' N. Long 150° 55' E

for Sperm Whale on Japan

Monday May 21st First part, light weather and very light air at S. E. steering to the Northward, saw Grampuses, latter part, steering to the South, wind S. E. at East, under the fore & main masts; saw Porpoises;

Lat 20° 27' N. Long 151° 27' E

Tuesday May 22nd First part, fine weather and moderate wind at S. E. steering N. E. at 7 P. M. latched ship to the South at 8 P. M. latched ship to the N. E. strong wind at P. M. employed making boat sails.

Lat 21° 59' N. Long 151° 23' E

Wednesday May 23rd First part, fine weather and moderate wind at S. E. steering to the N. E. employed making boat sails, saw a Gramp, latter part, wind P. M. light, steering S. E. started water.

Lat 21° 57' N. Long 151° 15' E

Thursday May 24th First part, cloudy with light wind at South, steering to the S. E. saw a piece of "fat bear", variously employed, latter part, light wind at S. W. steering S. E. saw Finbacks, and a very large piece of sperm.

Lat 21° 30' N. Long 150° 20' E

Friday May 25th First part, fine weather and calm, variously employed, saw a shark, latter part, calm.

Lat 21° 09' N. Long 150° 39' E

Saturday May 26th First part, fine weather and calm, saw Grampuses, variously employed, latter part, very light wind at N. P. M. steering East, saw Finbacks & Grampuses.

Lat 21° 51' N. Long 150° 22' E

Sunday May 27th First part, fair weather and very light breeze at N. S. W. steering S. E. saw Grampuses, latter part, a fine breeze at S. W. with very fair weather, steering variously employed, saw Grampuses & Porpoises.

Lat 21° 22' N. Long 150° 21' E

Monday May 28th Begins with a gentle breeze at P. M. with very fair weather, saw Finback & Porpoises, steering various courses, latter part, steering S. E. saw Finbacks & Porpoises, Grampuses.

Lat 21° 15' N. Long 150° 29' E

Tuesday May 29th Begins with a light breeze at West, with very fair weather, S. P. M. saw Grampuses, Finbacks & Porpoises, latter part, calm.

Lat 21° 13' N. Long 150° 09' E

Wednesday May 30th Begins with very light air at North, steering to the Eastward, saw Porpoises, employed scraping, topmasts, latter part, fair weather and variable wind, saw Porpoises & Finbacks, steering in various directions.

Lat 20° 24' N. Long 150° 09' E
