

Remarks on Board Ship *Norman* while cruising
Saturday July 8th First part fine weather and moderate wind
at 8 AM in pursuit of whales, with the ship at 4 o'clock lowered
our boat without success. at sundown took up the boat
latter part, wind N.E. weather fine.

Lat 51° 20' N. Long 160° 78' E

Sunday July 9th First part fine weather and moderate wind
at 8 AM saw a school of sperm whales going to windward
did not lower our boat. latter part at 4 o'clock
lowered our boat in pursuit of sperm whales
without success. at 7 o'clock took up the boat.

Lat 51° 20' N. Long 160° 78' E

Monday July 10th First part whales still in sight, at 1 o'clock lowered
our boat in pursuit, without success. latter part
nothing particular.

Lat 51° 20' N. Long 160° 29' E

Tuesday July 11th First part fine weather and moderate wind at
8 AM steering to the south variously employed, saw
jumps. latter part the same. steering North.

Lat 51° 40' N. Long 160° 10' E

Wednesday July 12th First part cloudy weather & some rain wind
at east steering North, caught some albacore. latter part
employed breaking out in the after hold. jib & tuck.

Lat 51° 20' N. Long 160° 13' E

Thursday July 13th First part cloudy weather and moderate
wind at east. steering to the North variously employed.
latter part at 6 o'clock lowered our boat for sperm
whales. much over took him alongside at 10 o'clock commenced
cutting. there was 4 whales, going S.W. quite moderate.

Lat 51° 38' N. Long 162° 30' E

Friday July 14th First part cloudy weather and moderate
wind at east. employed cutting, at 7 o'clock lashed down, came
alongside, at 2 o'clock chain parted and lost case.
latter part at 5 o'clock commenced boiling.

Lat 51° 21' N. Long 161° 38' E

Saturday July 15th First part cloudy weather and moderate
wind at east. employed boiling. latter part, same.

Lat 51° 20' N. Long 161° 49' E

Sunday July 16th First part clear weather and strong
gale at 6 P.M. employed boiling. latter part, same.

for Sperm Whales on Japan. 1851.
Monday July 17th Latter part at 5 o'clock finished boiling and
cleared up the deck.

Lat 51° 20' N. Long 160° 30' E

Tuesday July 17th First part clear weather and strong gale
at 8 AM. jibing, too under water in sail, latter part
employed at starting some sails out of school
side of ship, repairing cables. saw a school of sperm
whales. at 10 o'clock commenced boiling.

Lat 51° 19' N. Long 161° 10' E

Wednesday July 18th First part clear weather and strong gale at east. ship
headed south, employed making preparations for steering
down, a sail in sight, latter part employed cooping
our oil, and breaking out the fore hold.

Lat 51° 20' N. Long 160° 30' E

Thursday July 19th First part fine weather and moderate wind at
east. ship headed North, employed steering down our oil
to the board side of the fore hold, aft, nothing in sight.
latter part finished steering down.

Lat 51° 20' N. Long 160° 30' E

Friday July 20th First part fine weather and strong wind at
east. ship headed to south, variously employed, latter
part employed repairing, coops, catching fish &c.

Lat 51° 00' N. Long 160° 10' E

Saturday July 21st First part fine weather and moderate wind
at east. ship headed to the North by the wind, variously
employed, saw Finbacks, latter part, same the same.

Lat 51° 20' N. Long 161° 20' E

Sunday July 22nd First part fair weather and strong wind at
east. steering to the south, variously employed, caught some
albacore, latter part the same.

Lat 50° 20' N. Long 160° 00' E

Monday July 23rd First part fair weather and strong wind at
east, steering to the south, variously employed, latter
part, saw a school of sperm whales, lowered our boat
without success. at 11 o'clock took up the boat.

Lat 50° 20' N. Long 160° 20' E

Tuesday July 24th First part fair weather and strong wind
at east & steering to S.E. saw jumps. latter
part, steering to the North.

Lat 50° 10' N. Long 160° 20' E
