and moderate wind at N.W. steering to
N.E. variously employed, Middle & Latter part
no alteration, Latter part. saw several vessels

Monday June 11th First part. fair weather and
strong wind at North, steering to N.E. saw
several vessels. Latter part. saw Pinbacks, started water

Lat. 25° 23' P. Long. 25° 2' W.

Tuesday June 12th First part. fine weather and
moderate N.W. wind, steering to the N.E.
variously employed, Middle part. saw a sail.
Latter part. calm.

Lat. 24° 40' P. Long. 24° 00' W.

Wednesday June 13th First part. Begin with light
south wind, and rainy, steering North, saw Pinbacks
Middle part. calm, Latter part. strong winds at
N.W. steering to N.W. saw Pinbacks, variously employed

Thursday June 14th First part. fine weather and
strong winds at N.W. steering to N.W. variously employed
saw a sail, and many Pinbacks, Middle part. wind

Friday June 15th First part. fair weather and strong breeze
at N.W. steering to N.E. saw Pinbacks, variously
employed, Middle part. wind hauled to the South.
steering North, Latter part. saw a sail, employed sailing

Lat. 21° 51' P. Long. 26° 00' W.

Saturday June 16th First part. fine weather and moderate
south wind, steering North, passed English Ship *Helena*
of Belfast, employed Rattling, Latter part. wind P.E.

Lat. 19° 00' P. Long. 26° 40' W.

Sunday June 17th First part. fine weather and moderate
breezes at P.E. steering North, employed Rattling, saw Pinback
Middle part. baffling winds with some rain. Latter
part. same, with calm.

Lat. 17° 40' P. Long. 27° 4' W.

Monday June 18th First part. calm with light baffling
winds steering North, Middle & Latter part. employed
Rattling, and tanning, some rain, steering N by E

Lat. 16° 40' P. Long. 27° 17' W.

Tuesday June 19th First part. squally, wind from
N.E. to P.E., some strong squalls, employed Rattling
tanning, saw Pinbacks, steering North, Middle &
Latter part. same, saw gunpowder.

Lat. 15° 40' P. Long. 27° 27' P.

Wednesday June 20th First part. fine weather
and moderate winds at East, steering N.W. &
employed Rattling, Middle part. heavy squalls.
Latter part fine weather, finished the Riggering,

Lat. 12° 15' P. Long. 27° 00' W.

Thursday June 21st First part. fine weather and
moderate breezes, at P.E. steering N by E, variously
employed, Middle part no alteration, Latter part
saw a sail, employed placing spars & spars
