Monday June 25th First part, fair weather and
moderate P. & S. winds, steering variously. Middle &
Latter part, steering N. N. W. washed Ship
outside,

Lat 5° 27' S. Long 35° 40' W.

Tuesday June 26th First fine weather and strong
P. & S. breezes, steering N. N. W. commenced painting
Ship inside, Middle part same. Latter part
painting Ship all over, wind light,

Lat 4° 40' N. Long 35° 20' W.

Wednesday June 27th First part fair weather &
light wind at P. & S. steering N. by W. employed paint
Ship all over, Latter part, same, wind strong.

Lat 2° 49' N. Long 35° 10' W.

Thursday June 28th First part, fair weather and
strong breezes at P. & S. steering N. N. W. employed
painting Ship, Ship, Latter part, no alteration.

Lat 4° 15' N. Long 36° 50' W.

Friday June 29th First part, fine weather and
moderate P. & S. steering N. N. W. employed paint
Ship. Middle part, same. Latter part, changeable wind
with much rain steering N. W. Lat 6° 21' S. Long 27° 57' W.

in passage from Equator toward United States,
Saturday June 30th First part, changeable weather
and wind, wind all round the compass, steering
N. W. by N. plenty of rain, Abulm in pass.
Middle & Latter part, calm & light air, variable,

Lat 6° 21' N. Long 36° 50' W.

Sunday, July 1st First part, fair weather and light
breezes at N. W. steering N. N. E. by the wind, variously employed.
Middle & Latter part, calm & light air from all directions.

Lat 6° 30' N. Long 36° 49' W.

Monday, July 2nd First part, squally, with westerly
winds, steering N. W. saw Blackfish, great quantity
of rain. Middle & Latter part, one continual rain
wind from North to S. W.

Tuesday, July 3rd First part, fair weather and baffling
wind, could not N. W. rain in any quantities. Middle
& Latter part, calm, and light air from all quarters.
Started water, variously employed,

Lat 6° 30' N. Long 36° 37' W.

Wednesday July 4th First part, fair weather and calm
variously employed, Middle & Latter part, rain,
rain, rain, wind from all quarters, and no
wind at all, saw a sail.

Lat 6° 30' N. Long 36° 37' W.

Thursday, July 5th First part, rain, wind variable
course N. W. sometime, saw Blackfish, a sail in sight.
Middle & Latter part, much the same.

Lat 8° 30' N. Long 37° 29' W.

Friday July 6th First part, squally, with moderate
breezes at West, steering to N. N. W. caught a
Porpoise, Middle part, strong winds at West,
steering to N. N. W. Latter part, rainy, with
light variable wind.

Lat 9° 51' N. Long 37° 59' W.

Saturday, July 7th First part, squally with
variable wind, and calm, trying to get
to the N. W. at 3 P.M. took the lead, wind at
N. E. Did not know, a dog that I took from
Sunday island, I suppose he was poisoned by the
steward.
