Sunday July 8th First part, fair weather and strong
breezes at E. N. E. steering N. W. employed painting
yesterday, we were boarded by a Swallow, who
died today, a poor little fellow. Middle & Latter
parts, strong wind, steering N. W. by N.

Dist. run, 205 miles. Lat. 12° 39' N. Long 42° 27' W.
Monday July 9th First part, fair weather and strong
N. E. wind, steering N. W. by N. Middle part, no
alteration, Latter part, employed painting Ship
saw a cask afloat.

Dist. run, 201 miles. Lat. 14° 25' N. Long 43° 57' W.
Tuesday July 10th First part, fine weather and strong
breezes at E. N. E. steering N. W. by N. employed
painting, painted the Cabin, and I am now
suffering from the effects off, for I can hardly
write. Middle & Latter parts, small breezes.

Dist. run, 165 miles. Lat. 16° 00' N. Long 47° 50' W.
Wednesday July 11th First part fine weather and
light breezes at East, steering N. W. by N. employed
painting Middle & Latter part light wind,
painted our Boat, cleaned Brass Bells &c.

Dist. made 100 miles. Lat. 17° 7' N. Long 49° 37' W.
Thursday July 12th First part, fine weather and
light wind at E. N. E. steering N. W. by N. employed
variously, Middle & Latter parts wind light.

Lat. 18° 20' N. Long 51° 19' W.
Dist. made, 105 miles.
Friday July 13th First part, fine weather and light
wind at E. N. E. steering N. W. employed painting
here & there, about in spots. Middle part no
alteration. Latter part, started water, sent up
chizen royal mast,

Lat. 19° 25' N. Long 53° 00' W.
Dist. made, 116 miles.
Saturday July 14th First part, fine weather &
light wind at E. N. E. steering N. W. employed
fitting a fore top mast, Latter part, sent down
fore top mast and sent up another.
Dist. made 115 miles. Lat. 20° 40' N. Long 54° 50' W.

Sunday July 15th First part, fair weather and mod-
erate wind at East, sent up fore top gallant mast & yard
steering N. W. Middle & Latter part, squally, some.

Dist. made, 116 miles. Lat. 22° 25' N. Long 57° 10' W.
Monday July 16th First part, fair weather and moderate
wind at East, steering N. W. Middle part, same. Latter
part, sent up fore Bowed mast, otherwise variously employed.

Dist. made 110 miles. Lat. 20° 57' N. Long 59° 20' W.
Tuesday July 17th First part fair weather and moderate
breezes at E. N. E. steering N. W. by N. variously employed
Middle & Latter parts. Several slight squalls of rain
employed cleaning our craft.

Dist. made 141 miles. Lat. 25° 06' N. Long 60° 25' W.
Wednesday July 18th First part, fair weather and light
wind at E. N. E. steering N. W. by N. variously employed,
caught a Porpoise, saw Blackfish, Middle & Latter part
no material alteration.

Dist. made 117 miles. Lat. 27° 6' N. Long 62° 00' W.
Thursday July 19th First part fine weather and light
winds at East, steering N. W. by N. Middle &
Latter parts same. Dist. made 75 miles.

Lat. 28° 1' N. Long 63° 00' W.
Friday July 20th First part, fine weather and light
air at East, steering N. W. by N. saw a Barque,
the weather very warm, Middle & Latter part
same. Blacked the Bends, Dist. made, 50 miles.

Lat. 28° 44' N. Long 65° 00' W.
Saturday July 21st First part, fine weather and
light air at P. E. steering N. W. by N. (Hot at
Blaze) Middle & Latter part, same. 50 miles, Dist.

Lat. 29° 9' N. Long 64° 00' W.
Sunday July 22nd First part, fine weather and light
air at P. E. steering N. W. by N. saw Porpoise, Middle
& Latter part no alteration, calm, & light air
Hot: Hot: Hot enough to melt Iron,

40 miles Dist. Lat. 29° 34' N. Long 64° 34' W.
Monday July 23rd First part fine weather and light air
steering N. W. Middle part same. Latter part saw
two Tails, started water.
Lat. 30° 6' N. Long 66° 10' W.
