Island of Brown's Pass S.W. Steamer first
at 9.30 a.m. Capt Baker went on shore to trade

Commenced with light air at
6 p.m. Capt Baker came off with recruits and
2 men and a Boy kept off S all sail Ends with
fresh breeze from E.S.E. Course S all sail
