and thick rainy weather N.W. by E
S.W. & ends with thick haze with light
variable winds

rainy weather ends the same

Commenced with strong
breezes and thick haze from N.W. by E
S.W. & ends with fresh breeze with
rainy thick weather and veering to the
Westward

Commenced with fresh breezes
and thick rainy from S.W. heading
S.E. by the wind all sail made strong
breezes from N.W. ends with light breeze
from West

Commenced fine weather from
the Westward by the wind to the South all
sail ends with light breeze from the Westward
working to the Southward all sail

South all sail made light breeze and fine
weather ends with light breeze from the Eastward
Employed Rattling down Sea a main Rigging

Commenced with light breezes
and fine weather from the Eastward all
hands Employed Rattling down Sea
and main Rigging bent a New Lower Main
Top Sail Mould and latter thick and
rainy from E and S.E. heading to the
Southward

Commenced with thick rain
at 4 p.m. Fresh Gale headed the upper
Top Sail, Course and Gaff. Set Storm
Sail ends with a fresh Gale and thick
hazy weather from the Eastward

Commenced with a fresh Gale
from S.E. and veering to the N.W. by E
ends with thick haze
weather from the Southward by the wind to the
Eastward

few Finbacks working to the S.E. all sail
