Monday Dec 30th 1867

Commenced with fresh breezes and fine weather from N.W. all sail to the S. and S.E. Middle and latter fine weather from N.W. Course S.E. all sail

Tuesday Dec 31st

Fine weather and fresh breeze from N.W. Course S.E. all sail one ship in sight. Ends with fine weather from the Northward Course S.E. all sail saw a number of Finbacks 2 sail in sight

Wednesday Jan 1st 1868

Commenced with fine weather from the Northward Course S.E. all sail at 5 pm saw a shoal of Blackfish took 4 Middle fine weather ends with thick haze from N.W. Course S.E. all sail

Thursday Jan 2nd

Commenced with fresh breezes and thick haze weather from N.W. Course S.E. all sail. Ends with light breezes and thick haze at 4 am saw 1 right Whale covered 3 boats took them

Friday Jan 3rd

Commenced with light breezes from the Westward Employed finish at 9 pm Under the same latter Handed the Works had to cool down had a strong Gale from S.W. with rain

Commenced with a strong Gale from S.W. hauled main top sail Middle moderating top main top sail and fore sail started the Ironworks Ends fine all hand Employed boiling

Commenced with fine weather and fresh breeze from S.W. and veering to the Westward Employed boiling Ends with fine weather from the Northward Employed boiling

Commenced with fine weather from the Northward Steady off S.W. by S. saw a great number of Finbacks all hands Employed a boiling Middle fine weather Ends with strong breeze and rained boiling

Commenced with a fresh Gale from N.W. have to finish the boiling 3 pm Ends with a fresh Gale from the Westward have to with storm stay sail

Commenced with a fresh Gale from the Westward Course S.E. all sail single reefed top sail Middle. Strong breezes and fine weather from N.W. Course S.E. all sail Ends with light baffling air from N.W. with a heavy sea a running Emp Scraping Bone
