


Remarks On Board Spouts Northern Light-Of  
W.B.  Sunday Feb 9<sup>th</sup> 1868

Commenced with fine weather  
from N. course E.S. at 3 pm  
Saw 1 right Whale lower 3 boats  
took him had the Mast Boat Stove  
bad got the Whale to the Ship at 5 pm.  
Commenced bating the Piece tree had  
to let him lay till morning Capt  
Baker Sick Crew with strong breeze and  
thick rainy weather from the Westward but  
the Whale No Obs

Monday Feb 10<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with strong breeze  
and fine weather from the Westward cleared  
up and started the Works Capt Baker &  
Mr Silvey Sick layed up made thick  
and rainy crew with a heavy Gale  
from the Westward

Tuesday Feb 11<sup>th</sup>

Strong Gale from the Westward  
hauled main top sail Middle the same  
later moderating set main top sail finished  
Refracting W Boat Lat 42.31 S

Wednesday Feb 12<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with veered  
and strong breeze started the Works  
Capt Baker and Mr Silvey on deck  
a gain crew with light breeze from W  
Lat 41.55 S

Thursday Feb 13<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with light breeze from  
W starting off to the Eastward boiling  
Crew from 2 4 am cooler down Employed  
Coopering and Scraping Bone  
Lat 41.55 S

New Bedford Capt Michel Baker Master  
Friday Feb 14<sup>th</sup> 1868

Commenced with light breeze  
from the Westward course E.S. all sail  
Crew with strong breeze from Westward  
course E.S. all sail Employed washing  
Ship Mr Silvey very sick and one  
man sick forward

Saturday Feb 15<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with strong breeze  
and thick haze weather some E.S. all sail  
Crew the same Employed clearing up the  
Ship

Strong breeze and heavy course  
E.S. all sail Crew with fresh Gale from  
S course E and E.S. single reefed top  
sails

Commenced with a fresh Gale  
from S course E single reefed top sails  
Crew with a fresh Gale from the South course  
E and E.S. Lat 38.13 S

Tuesday Feb 18<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with fresh Gale from S.W.  
course E.S. at sunset shortened sail  
Crew with a strong breeze from S.W. and W  
course E.S. Lat 37.53 S

Commenced with a strong breeze  
from W and veering to the N.W. shortened  
Middle strong breeze Crew moderate from  
S.W. course E.S. all sail
