

Remarks On Board Bark Northern Light Of
Wednesday April 2nd 1868

Commenced with fine weather
from the Masthead at 2 pm came to anchor
in the Bay of Islands washed Ship and Sails
Mr Selvey a Shore Tender with fine weather

Thursday April 2nd

Commenced with fine weather
got off 75 lbs of water Employed Stowing coals
and getting ready for Water Ends the same

Friday April 3rd

Fine weather all Hands Employed Stowing
Water Sailing Lead Sails Painting Bends and
repairing the Copper Ends with fine weather
all hands Employed getting up hook for Water
breaking out and Stowing coals to make room

Saturday April 4th

Fine weather getting up Shirts and
getting out the Bone to wash Ends fine
all Hands Employed Washing Bone and filling
Water

Sunday April 5th

Commenced with fine weather
Watch a Shore in Liberty

Monday April 6

Commenced with fine weather
the Foreboard Watch in Liberty Employed Stowing
Water and breaking out Trade

Tuesday April 7th

Commenced with fine weather
Employed bundling Bone and Lard on Shore to
be shipped Sent on Shore 27 gals of fresh Oil
gals of Whale

New Bedford Capt Michel Baker Master
Wednesday April 8th 1868

Commenced with fine weather at 10
18 Casks of Potatoes and Stowed it - Filled Employed
Painting Ship outside

Thursday April 9th

Commenced with fine weather
Ship took 4 Bins of Potatoes Ends the same
Employed Painting Ship Watch in Liberty

Friday April 10th

Thick and stormy hauled the Ship
out in the Stream ready for sea Ends
the same

Saturday April 11th

Commenced with fine weather
with fresh breeze from N.E. at Meridian
Capt Baker came on board got underway
and stood out fine weather and pleasant
breeze from N.E. Mrs Baker on Shore

Sunday April 12th

Fine weather at 3 pm out sight
of the Heads Course S.W. by E all sail Stowed
the Anchors and Chances Ends with fine
weather and light breeze from the S Course
S.W. by E

Monday April 13th

Commenced with light breeze and
fine weather from S Course at Sunset
Shortened Sail for the Night Ends the same
Spoke the James Arnold 21 Ments out 21 00
25 00 and a 20 lb Whale alongside
